SECURITY AND DIRECTIONS: Enter the Main Gate on the east side of 278, go to the guest lane. At the gate house tell them that you are going to Hidden Cypress Golf Course to play in the Low Country Team Match, they will give you a pass. As you leave the gate, you will encounter your first stop sign and proceed straight ahead. You will encounter a total of 5 stop signs.

On the 5th stop sign, you will turn right. Then take your first right and follow the road, pass the clubhouse where you will see the bag drop. Parking will be located to your left. PLEASE BE AWARE, this area has a lot of thru traffic of cars, golf carts, and walkers. Registration and Pro Shop is in the clubhouse next to the bag drop.
