2027 DUES INCREASE

As noted above, the 2026 fiscal year is projected to close with a cash balance of **\$1,648**. To align with the Board's target of having an ending cash balance of approximately **\$3,000**, a two-year capital accumulation strategy has been initiated, and driven by a projected increase in our primary expense, the annual luncheon fee, a dues adjustment is required for the first time in over four years. Furthermore, bag handler fees will be increased by \$1 per bag.
