	Level 4 dogs spend the first 3 weeks of this program accomplishing Level 2 tasks, then spend the remaining 5 weeks focusing on problem behaviors dealing with aggression. This program introduces and reinforces more appropriate response mechanisms to triggers. Dogs must be muzzle trained prior to beginning this program. Includes a Mini Educator.
