Good Afternoon East Valley High School Family,

I am writing to provide an update regarding the COVID-19 situation. After the current news release from Governor Doug Ducey and Superintendent Kathy Hoffman, East Valley High School will be closed through Friday April 10th. The Governor and Superintendent Hoffman will continue to reassess the need for school closure through the end of the month. All online classes will continue to be accessible for our students. If your student is taking online courses, we strongly advise them to continue their progress over the next 2 days. If they have any questions, teachers will be available to help them. They can call the school for assistance 480-981-2008. East Valley High School has been in close contact with local, county, state, and federal health officials regarding Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). There are currently no cases of COVID-19 within the East Valley High School Family. This decision takes in mind the possibility of transmission of the virus to those within our communities that are medically fragile and/or immunocompromised.

We will be developing guidance for school during this time and we will provide you with updates as they become available. The current plan has East Valley High School reopening on 4/13/2020. If this changes, we will notify parents. If you did not receive a call or email from the school, please contact the school immediately to provide a correct phone number and email.

The health and safety of our students, staff, their families, and the communities we serve, are our highest priorities.
