## Distant Learning Plan

Dear Parent/Guardian,

East Valley High School is committed to creating a learning environment that supports the student success, even in the face of new challenges presented by the COVID-19 pandemic. Below is EVHS Distant Learning Plan.

### Required of Students:

- Students will be provided a school email they will use to access PEAK, our online curriculum.
- All students will be enrolled in their core classes using PEAK.
- Students will be required to log in daily, Monday through Thursday, to all of their classes in order to receive attendance. If students do not log in to PEAK daily during this time, they will be marked absent.
- Students will check in with each of their teachers twice per week. The times and methods will be determined by the assigned teacher. These methods can be any of the following:
  - email (preferred)
  - phone call
  - hangouts
  - instant messaging
  - Google Meets
  - Zoom
- Students are required to check their school email at least once per day. Students should respond to their teachers within 24 hours of receiving an email.
- Students will take all quizzes, tests and finals away from school.

### Required of Parents:

- Provide location for students to learn.
- Provide access to technology for learning to take place.
- If there are any unforeseen circumstances, parents are required to contact school.
- Keep in contact with all of their students' teachers.
- Monitor their students' progress.
- Proctor all quizzes, tests and final exams.

### Required of Teacher:

- Will be available for students through email during school Day.
- Will make contact with student(s) at least twice per week.
- Track contact with student(s).
- Inform assigned admin team member of any concerns.
