Ten Commandments for Puppets

- 1. No flying puppets! Enter the stage by walking up stairs; exit by turning away and walking down stairs.
- 2. Look at each other when talking to each other. Have your puppet look at the puppet or person talking.
- 3. Don't mouth every syllable! Open mouth only with stressed syllables.
- 4. Don't bite your words! Open mouth in sync with words; don't closes mouth with each word.
- 5. No catching flies! Close your puppet's mouth when not talking.
- 6. No noses in the air! Look down at the audience so they can see the puppet's eyes. Remember, they may be sitting on the ground or floor.
- 7. No naked puppets! Keep puppets hidden in a box or bag when not performing; adds to the believability.
- 8. No switching arms in the middle of a skit! Support the puppet arm with the other arm if you have to.
- 9. No leaning against the stage! It might fall over and crush your audience!
- 10. Ham it up and have fun!
