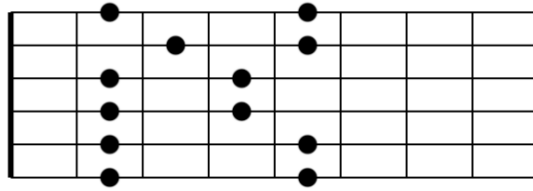

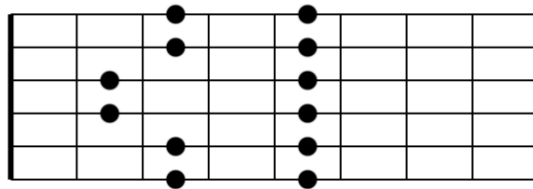


Pentatonic Scale starting on 3<sup>rd</sup> in G major/5<sup>th</sup> in E minor



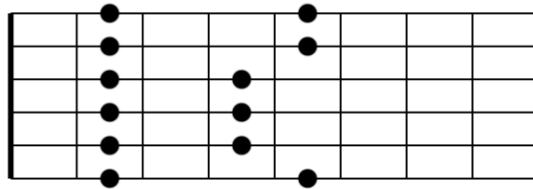
