## Parent Note Zone

#### Here is how I organize my Parent Note Zone:

- 1. Create a zone that is specifically designed for parents to leave notes for either their student, or for you.
  - a. Parents can write a note to students for the first day of school, you will happily place it on their desk.
  - b. Parents can write any pertinent information regarding their student for the teacher to know.
- 2. Have clear signage and an example for parents to follow.
- 3. If parents have personal information to share, please direct them to the "Note Zone" and reassure them that you will contact them within 24 hours and can speak over the phone or set up a meeting.
  - a. This keeps private matters private (FERPA)
  - b. Parents know that you care, and want to protect students and help in any way.



### Parent Note Zone

Dear Parents, am so excited to meet you and your student! Tonight can get crazy, if you would like to share something, please jot me a note; this will ensure that I can soak in any information that you would like to share and can specifically address any needs or questions you might have within the next 24 hours. If you would like to leave a note for your student for the first day of school, please fill out a card, and I will happily place the note on their desk so that they can read it when they arrive. Please place all notes in the basket.
