The meeting was called to order at 7:02pm with the pledge to The United States Flag and prayer.

A motion was made to enter into executive session to discuss public employees and employee compensation. *A motion was made by Ms. Vance, a second by Ms. Turner. Roll call was taken and all members voted yes, motion carried. Executive Session began at 7:04pm.*

A motion was made to exit executive session at 8:05 by Mr. Puckett, seconded by Ms. Lyons. Roll call was taken and all members voted yes, motion carried.

A recommendation was made coming out of executive session that employee Robert ^{McKer}Turner and Timothy Mock pay be increased to \$25.00 per hour and the open position for the service department be advertised at \$18.00 per hour. The annual pay for the new chief has been set at \$41,600 for 80 hours per pay period. The court clerk salary would increase to \$6,000 per year based on 300 hours per year. *A motion was made by Ms. Lyons, seconded by Ms. Vance. Roll call was taken and all members voted yes, motion carried.*

Upon recommendation of the finance committee that we approve the temporary budget to submit to Jill Hall. *A second was made by Ms. Webster. Roll call was taken and all members voted yes, motion carried.*

A recommendation was made coming out of executive session that a \$300.00 leather allowance for the seven auxiliary officers would be given and for the four full time employees a \$150.00 gift card be given. *A motion was made by Mr. Puckett, seconded by Mr. North. Roll Call, North-yes, Puckett, yes, Vance, yes, Lyons, no, Turner, yes, Webster, yes. Motion carried.*

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Mr. Puckett, seconded by Ms. Turner, all approved. Meeting adjourned.
