Sale of Police cruisers was completed to Village of Manchester for \$3500, second cruiser was traded to Chicago Motors for trade of \$6500. Purpose for sales is to upgrade the Police fleet. Studies were done regarding selling current cruisers Purchase was made for a 2018 Tahoe for \$18,000. The new Tahoe also has is K9 ready which should be operational next week.

Grant program for next year that is being looked at that will give 50% of purchase for a new Tahoe to add to the police fleet.
