MPP has prioritized constructing a strong foundation through building productive partnerships and utilizing technical assistance to gather the pieces for a data-driven road map towards desirable economic development. We have hosted the Maryland National Capital Park & Planning (MNCPPC) Chair for the Prince George's County Planning Board, Peter Shapiro and his Team to share the development vision of Marlboro Pike. MPP was selected for the Planning Assistance for Municipalities and Communities grant and later confirmed by the Planning Board. This will inform our economic development plan by drafting a market feasibility study through hired consultants.

Our Government Partners Committee met on several occasions throughout the year at local sites such as Bistro64 and Bishop McNamara High School to coordinate collaborative revitalization efforts such as improving curb appeal and the state of public safety. During the Summer, we co-hosted community events such as the annual Juneteenth Celebration led by local churches such as Hemingway A.M.E. and the City of District Heights. On the Eve of Thanksgiving, we hosted our first public facing meeting introducing MPP to residents and gathering feedback on the future of The Pike. This input will be incorporated into the study's final report. The grant funds awarded will fuel certain recommendations generated from the study in future fiscal years.
