Funded Early Education Hours

We accept Government-funded early education places of:

- **15 hours per week**
- **30 hours per week**
- Funded for **38 weeks per year**

Funded hours contribute towards your child’s place; however, as a specialist early intervention setting with enhanced staffing ratios and therapeutic support, an additional specialist fee applies.

SEND Specialist Support Fee

The Nurture Nest is not a standard nursery provision. We operate as both a nursery and an early intervention centre, providing a highly supported environment for children with additional needs.

Our specialist fee reflects the enhanced level of care, staffing and therapeutic provision we provide.

Additional SEND Specialist Fee (for 15 funded hours)

- **9 months – 2 years:** £80 per week
 - **2-year-olds:** £120 per week
 - **3-year-olds:** £160 per week
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Why our fees increase

In most nurseries, fees reduce as children get older because Government funding increases and Ofsted adult-to-child ratios allow larger groups (for example, 1:5 under 3s and up to 1:13 for children aged 3+).

At The Nurture Nest, we maintain a consistent **1:3 adult-to-child ratio** throughout your child’s early learning journey, regardless of age.

As Government funding decreases for older children but we continue to provide the same high level of specialist support, our additional SEND specialist fee increases accordingly.

This ensures every child continues to receive intensive, personalised support in a nurturing environment.

What the SEND Specialist Fee Includes

Your child will benefit from:

- ✓ Higher staffing ratio – 1 adult to every 3 children
 - ✓ SEND-trained and experienced staff
 - ✓ An individualised learning plan tailored to your child's needs
 - ✓ Therapy programmes embedded into daily practice
 - ✓ Regular review meetings with families and professionals
 - ✓ Early Help Assessment (EHAP) opened where appropriate
 - ✓ Referrals and liaison with additional professionals if needed
 - ✓ Multi-agency working to ensure joined-up support
 - ✓ Home support- resources, social stories etc
 - ✓ Access to our specially designed centre, including:
Dedicated Sensory Room, Specialist equipment and therapeutic resources
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- ◆ All session requirements must be confirmed in writing.
 - ◆ Children will eventually be registered for a minimum of either two full day sessions per week or three morning and/or afternoon sessions per week.
 - ◆ Changes to session days may be accommodated subject to availability. For the nursery to manage irregular booking patterns, any changes must be confirmed in writing by both parties at least one month in advance.
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Fee Payment

- ◆ A registration fee of £75.00 is payable alongside this Registration Form.
- ◆ Nursery fees must be paid one month in advance and before the first day of every month. All invoices are issued monthly via email.
- ◆ Payment must be made by standing order or online bank transfer. A £10 administration fee will be charged on a weekly basis for all late payments.
- ◆ For children with a start date three or more months in advance, a deposit of £150.00 will be required. This deposit will be deducted from the first month's invoice once the child starts at the nursery. Deposits are non-refundable.

Holidays

- ◆The nursery is closed for two weeks at Christmas, 1 week at Easter and 3 weeks in the summer for the year 2026 and on all Bank Holidays. No fees are charged during these closures. Please find term dates on our website: www.nurturenesteic.com
- ◆The nursery may close for up to four days per year for staff training. Parents will be given a minimum of six weeks' notice.

Sickness, Absence and Lateness

- ◆Children who have, or develop, an infectious illness must be excluded from the nursery for a minimum of 48 hours. This is in the best interest of the child and the other children and complies with regulations set by the Environmental Health department. Please see our sick policy for further details
- ◆The Nursery must be notified of all absences as soon as possible via telephone or email.
- ◆Sickness or absences from Nursery does not qualify for reduction in fees.
- ◆Late collection charges apply at £10.00 for every 10 minutes beyond the agreed collection time.

Notice Periods and Changes to Sessions

- ◆A minimum of one month's written notice is required by either party to terminate a child's nursery place. Fees remain payable throughout the notice period even if the child does not attend.
- ◆One month's written notice is required for any reduction in attendance days or changes to session times. Fees remain payable during the notice period regardless of attendance.

Clothing and Personal Items

- ◆The nursery cannot accept responsibility for the loss or damage of personal items or clothing. Parents must supply suitable clothing for daily wear, including a spare change of clothes in case of accidents.
- ◆During warmer months, parents should provide sun cream and a sun hat. Suitable outdoor clothing and footwear must be provided at all times. All items must be clearly labelled with the child's name.
- ◆Parents are responsible for supplying nappies, wipes, and suitable water or milk bottles for their child.

Health and Development

- ◆Parents must provide a copy of their child's red book upon registration. Any health needs, allergies, or dietary requirements must be disclosed to the nursery.
- ◆Parents are encouraged to attend termly parent consultations to discuss their child's development.

Car Parking

There are designated parking bays for dropping off and collecting children ONLY, these are three spaces to the front of the Nursery

However, if these bays are full, please ensure that you park your car carefully. Under no circumstances should any car be le^{ft} parked in an unsuitable manner that could cause danger to children or to the general public.
