Old Business:

- 1. Tower at Station # 3: CF&R is currently still waiting for Tiger Blue to contact regarding the pickup of the tower, Chief Stacey will contact and see if they are still interested.
- 2. Update on PIER Grant: The Pier grant is moving along; a new engine has been selected and has been placed on hold for CF&R. The engine currently has a 750-gallon tank and will be converted to 1000 gallons.
- 3. Awards Banquet: The awards banquet was held at the Train Mountain on August 16, 2025, the next banquet will be in March 2026.
- 4. Tribal Contract: Sec. / Treas. Cheryl Hescock is working on rescheduling the next meeting with The Klamath Tribes. Sec. / Treas. Cheryl Hescock contacted other tribes within the state on how they pay for fire protection services.

New Business:

- 1. Budget Committee Opening: There is currently an opening on the Budget Committee. Mr. Campbell has resigned from his position on the committee.
- 2. Hose Testing: VP Brandon Fowler made a motion to allow Chief Stacey to proceed with the purchase of a hose tester, Seconded by BM Kevin Moore. This hose tester will allow for testing to be done in-house.

- 3. Budget Committee Appointments: The Budget Committee opening will be posted on the CF&R Facebook page, community newsletter, and community bulletin boards.
- 4. Oregon Hazards Lab: The Oregon Hazards Lab is part of the University of Oregon's camera network. They would like to put up a microwave dish at the Stieger Butte tower. The camera will be used for wildfire detection. A motion was made by VP Brandon Fowler to allow Chief Stacey to sign a contract with U of O's hazards lab, Seconded by BM Anna Fowler.

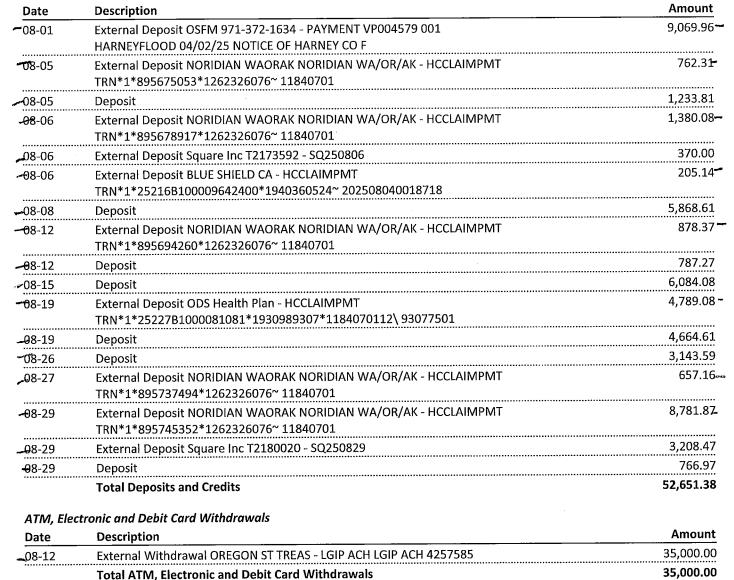
