Fair feedback:

- Show order needs to be addressed.
- Ring etiquette needs to be a part of preshow prep for all junior fair participants.
- It was considered to suggest to non 4H members to join 4H. If not joining 4H, consider inviting them to educational opportunities (no horses because of insurance coverage).
- Another suggestion was to have warm up for open riders separate from junior fair riders.
- At the gymkhana show, a suggestion was to use the large area for warm up. The ring should be dragged after the warm-up before the first class.
- The gymkhana show was discussed; the show was larger, and the length is a concern. Moving the mounted shooter show was discussed.
- Promoting the gymkhana show and the pleasure show in area businesses was discussed; youth could create a flyer for promotion at the businesses, Facebook, clubs, etc. Gymkhana show flyers could be also posted on the fairs grounds during the week of fair.
- Consider moving costume class to end of gymkhana. Concerns were made that few people were able to enjoy the costume class.
- Help was plentiful. Kyle Breaker needs a show dad t-shirt.
- More information needs to be shared for the potluck. Roskums donated the hotdogs.
- Clinics need to be planned earlier, especially for the money and location of the big clinics.
- Clinics with clinicians were better attended.
- The overlap with livestock was unfortunate. This year the livestock dates are the third Thursday of June and the follow week Tuesday and Thursday.
- There was good feedback for the judge.
- We should collect suggestions from the general membership at the October meeting. Below are suggestions from the board:

Board member elections: We need VP, secretary, adult board. We need four youth, too. Suggestions are Danielle, Kyle, Amberly for adult members.

State: Keira reported a lot of state updates from the state meeting Aug. 28. Highlights include a decrease in participants at EXPO. October 1 is the deadline for the T-shirt competition. The state show may adjust for walk/trot classes and canter classes, open to all horse and horseless horse members. Sharing of horses may be allowed among nonfamily members. Education Days has a new location at UW Green Bay. The state needs more volunteers to learn roles in order to keep the organization running.
