At the end of the year, when you turn in your hours, if you spend 150 or more hours with your project horse, you will receive a plaque with an engraved disk with the hours you spent with your horse to add to your plaque. If you do not achieve 150 hours, that is OK. Just keep track and turn in your hours, as all members will be recognized.

Hours logged must be from the current 4-H calendar year. October 1-September 30 . Logged hours are due to the Horse Association by October 7 of the current year.
