Young Children's Classes age 3 & up: Target dance fundamentals, musicality, and creativity. Combo classes are a great way to explore 2 genres in one!

Leveled Classes: Level 1 (early beginner), 2 (adv-beginner), 3 (early-intermediate), 4 (intermediate), 5 (adv-intermediate), 6 (early-advanced), 7 & up (advanced)

"YBC" Youth Ballet Company: Dancers must audition for this pre-professional ballet program for students level 4 & up. Visit our YBC website page for info.

Team TADA: TADA's competitive dance team for ages 5 & up. Dancers must audition for this program. Visit our Team website page for info.

"PRO" Classes: Pre-professional classes for dancers on Team and/or YBC, and/or by specific approval from team and/or ybc directors.

BoomTADA Hip Hop Crew: An awesome team of kids who love hip hop and love to perform! Visit our website CREW page for more info

RAD Ballet Classes: Royal Academy of Dance classes are ballet certification courses with exams to track progress. Additional \$75-100 per exam.

Musical Theater: Age 9 & up class performs in a Fall & Spring Musical, no recital (Additional \$50/semester). Age 6+ students will perform in the recital.

Open Dance/Acro: Class explores a variety of dance styles, changing every 6-8 weeks, but always ends with acrobatics. Ballet, Jazz, Hip Hop, Lyrical, and More

Acrobatics "Acro": A blend of dance and floor gymnastics; young children's classes work on basic tumbling skills, strength, and balance to start.

Drill Team: Classes focus on leaps, turns, kicks, audition preparation, and other skills for drill team dancers – beginner through advanced, ages 9 and up

FALL/SPRING TUITION 2019-2020

TUITION IS A WHOLE AMOUNT FOR THE YEAR, OR MIN 30 CLASSES AUG 19-MAY 17

- 1 Class/week: \$750/year, or \$75 /month for 10 months
- 2 Classes/week: \$1150/year, or \$115/month for 10 months
- 3 Classes/week: \$1450/year, or \$145/month for 10 months
- 4 Classes/week: \$1650/year, or \$165/month for 10 months
- 5 Classes/week: \$1850/year, or \$185/month for 10 months
- 6 Classes/week: \$2050/year, or \$205/month for 10 months
- 7 Classes/week: \$2250/year, or \$225 /month for 10 months
- 8 Classes/week: \$2500/year, or \$250 /month for 10 months
- 9-13 Classes/week: \$3000/year, or \$300/month for 10 months
- 14 & up Classes/week: \$3200 starting, \$20 per additional class

REGISTRATION, RECITAL FEES, and MISC FEES

- Due at registration: Registration fee, FIRST & LAST month's tuition installment, bank draft and credit card info
- Discounted registration fee for monthly tuition payment by bankdraft: \$50 first student, and \$25 each additional; \$100 maximum family
- Registration fee for monthly tuition payment by credit card: \$80 first student, and \$30 each additional; \$150 maximum family *excludes Pro
- Recital Costume Fees Due Nov 1st: \$60 & up tax Age 6 & under, and \$75 & up tax Age 7 & up, due Nov 1st
- Recital Fee per family Due Feb 1st includes performance costs and 2 free tickets:
 - \$109 includes the above plus unlimited high-res downloads of all recital photos from picture week, HD videos, & action shots at the recital
 - \$70 without photo/video/action shots (no photos taken during picture week/recital; videos-only available for \$50 additional ala carte)
- Adult Classes: Registration & registration fee required; optional \$100 class card for 7 classes available.
- RAD Classes: Students must pay the National RAD exam fee of \$75-\$110 (varies)
- Musical Theater Classes: \$50/family per semester performance fee (no recital for MT students)

DISCOUNTS AND SPECIALS

- 10% sibling tuition discount for immediate family members living in the home (applies to lowest tuition amount)
- Boys: Waived tuition for boys, except for the recital & costume fees *Students will be dropped for more than 3 absences in a row, other exceptions apply
- 5% discount for paying a single non-refundable full-year 10 month tuition payment by check
- Discounted registration fee for families paying tuition throughout the year by bank draft, cash, or check.
- During Bring-A-Friend Week, special discounts apply if your friend registers – see website for details

FINANCIAL POLICIES: Access to your account & billing information can be found on your PARENT PORTAL, accessible only with the valid email address you provide at registration. Bank draft required for payment; cash/checks acceptable. If bank draft is rejected, the credit card on file will be processed along with a \$35 returned check fee. Higher registration fee applies to customers paying yearly tuition via credit card. If a customer changes to credit card payments, the registration fee difference will apply. All payments are non-refundable and non-transferrable. Tuition is divided into 10 equal installments over one school year, August thru May, due on the 1st of each month based on a min of 30 active weeks classes will be in session due to holidays, breaks, inclement weather, and other interruptions. Tuition does not vary or pro-rate even in the event of absences, holidays, days in the month, etc. and TADA follows the CISD calendar for closures with some exceptions. Missed classes can be made up with office permission within 2 weeks of the missed class; no refunds for missed classes. Dropping a class must be done in writing 30 days in advance, otherwise tuition will be charged on the 1st of that month. Class changes after registration will incur a change fee of \$20. Payments made AFTER the 3rd will incur a late fee of \$15, and a \$35 fee will be applied to all returned checks. Students will be dropped from a class or recital costume withheld for accounts unpaid more than 21 days after due date. Late pick up fee is \$1/minute if a child is not picked up within 5 minutes after class. TADA reserves the right to cancel or change a class due to enrollment of less than 5 students.

*For easier payment, we are happy to break up your tuition into monthly installments. Each installment is payment towards the whole tuition amount, not payment towards just that month's classes. If paying by installment, then the first & final months' tuition is due with registration fee at the time of registration. Payments are drawn automatically via bankdraft. Cash or check is acceptable. *For those paying yearly tuition by bank draft, a discounted registration fee applies. A credit card is required in case payment is rejected.*

DRESS CODE

TADA Tinies – pink leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes. Hair in a bun/pony.

Creative Ballet and Ballet Combo Classes for younger children (ballet/tap, ballet/acro, etc):

Pink OR black leotard (with the exception of PreBallet-see ballet-specific classes below), pink tights, pink ballet shoes, or black tap/jazz shoe if required. If class has acrobatics, pink transition tights are required to expose feet. Boys: white or black tank or shirt, black leggings/tights, black shoes. *If class is ballet/jazz, ballet shoes may be worn for entire class.

Ballet Classes (PreBallet through Level 8): MOTIONWEAR brand leotard in the color for your level listed below, any style, with pink split-sole canvas/Leather ballet shoes (or pink pointe shoes), hair in NEAT bun. SEAMED TIGHTS, PINK.

Pre-Ballet 1: PINK Pre-Ballet 2: TURQUOISE Level 1: RASPBERRY

Level 2: FUCHSIA Level 3: ULTRAVIOLET Level 4: BRIGHT RED

Level 5: ROYAL BLUE Level 6: HUNTER GREEN Level 7: MAROON Level 8 & up: BLACK

Boys Ballet: White or black shirt, black tights/leggings, black ballet shoes.

Hip Hop: Girls and boys- any style of top/shorts, and clean sneakers or boots

Acrobatics: Classes taken in bare feet; transition tights may be worn. Girls wear any color leotard or tight-fitting top, tight-fitting dance shorts, with hair in a low pony/braid (no buns). Boys wear any shirt, pants/shorts, tighter-fitting is best.

Musical Theater: ALL BLACK attire, dancewear/gym attire, any color sneakers/dance shoes

Level One & up Jazz, Tap, Combo Classes, & Other: Girls' attire is any color. For jazz/tap and other technique classes, attire must be tight-fitting to the body with leggings or shorts, and a leotard/dance top. Tan jazz shoes are recommended for performances and recital. "Pirouettes" may be worn in class at dancer's discretion. Tap shoes: BLACK. Boys may choose to wear dance attire OR more loose-fitting t-shirts, tank tops, shorts or pants, any color, with correct shoes.

*If class is a ballet/jazz class, ballet shoes may be worn for the entire class.

Adult: Adults wear any attire in which they can comfortably move.

RAD: RAD has separate, specific attire and shoes – see website for details.

STUDIO POLICIES: KNOW BEFORE YOU REGISTER

In order to preserve the harmony and safety of the studio and our families, TADA reserves the right to drop a student from a class, or a family from the studio for actions that work in opposition to our studio policies:

- The studio communicates primarily via email - **parents must have a valid email address on file** in order to receive vital updates and studio info, which also distributed via website and social media. We encourage you to visit often, and to "Like" our Facebook Page for additional notifications.
- Age requirements for each class are as of September 1st, 2019; we do this to keep things fair and to keep uniformity across age/maturity/ability levels.
- Classes with an asterisk * on the schedule do NOT participate in the recital. Classes that do participate require a costume fee and the recital fee.
- Students will be accepted into a class at the teacher's discretion or evaluation based on capability, technical level, attention span, and other factors.
- Students must adhere to dress code requirements and be properly dressed and ready by the start of class.
- Parents may not leave young children age 6 and under unattended at the studio, and must be present particularly during classes in case of any problems, for restroom use, etc.
- ONLY WATER is allowed in the restrooms and in the dance rooms.
- Make up classes are readily available for missed classes. We suggest that students arrange for a make-up class if more than 15 minutes late to receive full benefit from your class.
- Parents must be sure their child has used the restroom BEFORE class begins.
- During class if a student complains of being ill, or sustains an injury and cannot participate, the instructor or office will notify parents immediately.
- Parents and/or responsible parties must familiarize themselves with fees and financial info BEFORE registering, particularly recital and costume fees, refund policy, and more so there are no surprises.
- The following are strictly prohibited from the studio and its property: smoking, drugs or illegal substances, weapons, and any other item deemed harmful to the safety and well-being of the families and students.
- TADA reserves the right to drop students from classes or to ask them to leave a class for disruptive behavior, bullying, excessive tardiness and/or absences, or any other harmful conduct, as this negatively affects the quality of dance education for all students in the classroom.
- Cameras and videotaping in the restrooms and/or dressing areas are strictly prohibited.
- Families must respect the studio by cleaning up after themselves, throwing away their trash, etc.
- Please note that the studio is under 24 hour surveillance both in the classrooms and throughout the building.
- The lost and found box will be emptied at the end of every month, and its contents donated to a local church. The studio is not responsible for items that are lost, stolen, or damaged.
- Lockers are available for rental for those who would like to store personal items at the studio.
