Please join us for our 6<sup>th</sup> annual recital “Dancing Through the Decades” Sat-Sun, May 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>. Our recital will celebrate all the classics from the sixties, seventies, eighties, and beyond! The recital will be held at Magnolia HS Theater at 14350 FM 1488, Magnolia, TX 77354.

**FIVE separate dress rehearsals and performances (rehearsals will be on the same day as the performances):** Show A, Show B, Show C, Show D, and Show E. **Please check the program line up listed in this packet to find out which show your dancer is in.** Each dance will rehearse on stage in full make up/costume during the recital weekend, and then perform in the actual SHOW shortly thereafter (in other words, twice). For example, dancers in Show A would come fully dressed from 815-930am so they can rehearse on stage. THEN, Show A dancers will perform in the REAL THING from 10-11am. The same goes for Show B, C, D, and E. Anyone can watch the dress rehearsal in open seating, and use that time for video/pictures; however, the actual show will require a ticket and flash photography/video will be prohibited.

**Recital Tickets and TADA Family Discount Code:** Tickets on sale April 13<sup>th</sup> at 10am on our RECITAL PAGE. Tickets must be purchased separately according to show- so if your dancer is in more than one show, you must purchase tickets to both shows. Call us or email us [frontdesk@dancetada.com](mailto:frontdesk@dancetada.com) for or your unique TADA family code worth \$20 off (the cost of two tickets, general admission seating, which was included in your recital fee). Tickets are \$10, \$18, OR \$25, reserved seating. If your dancer will be sitting in a seat, he/she will need a ticket. If you're holding a child on your lap, he/she will not need a ticket.

**When to drop off/pickup your dancer backstage:** Dancers performing in the first half, Act One must be dropped off backstage with the room mom/teacher 15 minutes before show time. Dancers performing in the second half, Act Two, must be dropped off *during intermission*. Act One Dancers may be picked up to go to the audience at intermission, or you may choose to leave your dancer backstage with staff for the entirety of the show. **Please be aware that an adult will need to sign in and sign out for your child.**

**Finale for each show: OPTIONAL:** All dancers are invited to participate in the finale for their respective shows. We will be practicing this at the dress rehearsal. See the program line up for finale details. Dancers participating must be dropped off backstage in their last costume with staff to line up either at intermission or at least *four dances* before the end of the show unless you would prefer your dancer to be held backstage for the duration of the show.

**Pictures/Flash Photography:** Cameras and video will be permitted during dress rehearsals, but not during the show. Bella Media will make all photos and videos available for HD download ONLY to families who have already purchased the all-inclusive photo/video package (this included all photos from picture week, and was applied to your bill in early spring unless you opted out). Didn't purchase the package? It's not too late to at least have the low rate for your video and action shots. Email [tadadanceinfo@gmail.com](mailto:tadadanceinfo@gmail.com) if you'd like to apply the \$50 to your account.

**Recital Make Up:** Though performance make up is at parental discretion, we recommend stronger-than-normal colors because the bright lights on the stage can really wash out faces/expressions. We recommend eyeshadow in dark browns/plums, black mascara and/or eyeliner (waterproof in case of tears, top of the eye only), blush in a deep pink/rosy color, and lipstick in deep red that is NON-STAINING.

**Recital Tshirt Orders:** Order deadline for recital shirts is May 5<sup>th</sup>. Order easily online on our recital page!

**Recital Gifts/Flowers:** Gifts and flowers will be available while supplies last in the lobby for each show.

**Youth Volunteers please?** If you have a responsible child age 10 and up who would like to gain volunteering hours for an organization, or would just like to help out of kindness, please email [officemanager@danceTADA.com](mailto:officemanager@danceTADA.com) or stop by the front desk. We would love love love your help staffing the recital – ushers, stage hands, and more are very much needed. Adults are of course welcome too.)

**Daddy Daughter Dance Opening Act, Show B and C only (age 5 and up):** Calling all daddies, granddaddies, or dad-representatives willing to get on stage with your dancer – even if you’ve never danced before! Sign up by April 1st (spaces limited to 20 couples) to perform in the opening act of show B and/or C in an easy and fun upbeat dance we promise you CAN do alongside your dancer! There are two mandatory rehearsals (see below). Participation is free, however daddy and dancer must both purchase a recital tshirt to wear on stage for the performance. You can order your recital shirt online before May 5th on our recital page. Mandatory Rehearsals: Friday May 1<sup>st</sup> and Friday May 8th: 630-715 Show B and 715-8 Show C (same time both Fridays).

**TADA Tinies & Daddies, Show A only:** At the end of each performance of the TADA Tinies Classes in Show A, dancers will wait on stage to be picked up by their daddies who will rise from the audience to do so. If dad is not available, a representative is welcome. You may bring flowers to your dancer up on stage if you’d like... feel free to wave or dance with your Tiny before returning to your seat!

Your child’s class picture and individual photo in costume will be taken during your child’s class time by BellaVista Productions, and the pictures will be available for purchase. *Please have CLEAN shoes and clean tights for pictures.* Extra tights are available at the front office. It is best to make sure that your costume has been tried on and any alterations made before picture week. P.S. If you are placing a recital ad, the pictures from this week work great!
