## COVID-19 UPDATE AND PROTOCOL FOR SUMMER CLASSES

### Drop Off and Pick Up

- Parents must drop off and pick up at the designated side door at the exterior of the building. For rooms A, B, & G, these doors are glass, located at the front (East side) of the building facing Hanna Road. For rooms C & D these doors are also glass, located on the south side of the building facing the building across the parking lot and Alana Lane. On arrival, students will have their temperature taken and must sanitize hands.
- Exception: Students who are in multiple back-to-back classes can exit through the door adjacent to the gallery.

### Gallery Area Restrictions, and Virtual Viewing

- For students ages 5 and up, parents and family members will not be allowed to wait in the gallery – pick up and drop off at exterior doors only. See “Drop off and Pick Up” below. Everyone can view the class virtually.
- For students ages 4 and under ONLY, one parent or family representative may wait in the gallery *only if absolutely necessary according to the immediate needs of your 4 and under child*. Drop off at the exterior door, and walk around to the main entrance where your temperature will be taken before entering the gallery. You must still exit and pick up your child at the exterior door – see instructions for “Drop Off and Pick Up” below.
- Gallery viewing windows will be covered to discourage congregating, but all classes will be visible virtually and parents are welcome to watch the whole class on their mobile devices or computers. State of the art equipment, screens, and wireless mics will be utilized by the staff to deliver the best class both in person and virtually. This is for students who wish to take class from home, and for parents to view the class while it is occurring. On the last day of summer classes, we will have a fun end-of-year virtual invitational, allowing grandparents and loved ones to watch your child's last day.

### Routine Efforts to Maintain a Sanitary Environment

- High power UV filter units installed in all seven A/C systems continuously circulate and disinfect the air
- Janitorial team devoted to regular and thorough disinfecting/sanitizing of all surfaces in studio
- Staff will disinfect the floors, barres, and any other space that has been touched before/after EVERY class
- Temperatures will be taken of everyone who enters; those higher than 100.3F will not be admitted, but first allowed to wait in an isolated area in case the summer heat is the root cause. If after 5 minutes the temperature remains high, they will not be allowed in the building
- Floors are marked for more than 6 feet apart in all classrooms, at all barres, and around perimeter for appropriate social distancing between students
- Students and Staff will sanitize their hands before/after EVERY class
- Water fountains, vending machines, snacks, cubbies, lockers, coffee bar, children's play area, and homework room closed
- Reusable water bottles left behind will be disposed of (disposable water bottles can be purchased at front desk)
- Exterior door entrances for pick up and up/drop off, and gallery restrictions
- All classes will be offered for students to take virtually if not ready to return in person
- Flexible dress code: Students welcome to wear long leggings and long sleeves if they wish to protect more of their body
- Students/Parents cannot be admitted who are sick, or who have been exposed to someone diagnosed with COVID-19.
- All parents, students, and staff must strictly follow the guidelines recommended by the CDC to protect themselves and others from COVID-19, including but not limited to washing hands or sanitizing hands often, staying home if sick, covering sneezes/coughs, and maintaining social distance of 6 feet or more. ## SUMMER 2020 DRESS CODE

*Due to COVID-19, we welcome all students to cover up in long sleeves and leggings regardless of dress code if they prefer. Also please note ballet colors are not required.*

**TADA Tinies:** pink leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes. Hair in a bun/pony.

**Creative Ballet and Ballet Combo Classes (ballet/tap, tap/jazz, etc):** Pink OR black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, or black tap/jazz shoe if required. Boys: white or black tank or shirt, black leggings/tights, black shoes. \*If class is a ballet/jazz class, ballet shoes may be worn for the entire class. Hair in a bun or ponytail, up and out of the face.

**Girls Ballet (PreBallet through Level 8):** For the Summer, color-specific leotards are not required; any color leotard is permissible with pink split-sole canvas/leather ballet shoes (or pink pointe shoes), with SEAMED pink ballet tights, and hair in a bun. If you wish to purchase your Fall Ballet Leotard color you may do so in MOTIONWEAR BRAND according to your level below, available at our front desk, Jazz Rags, or online:

Pre-Ballet 1: PINK Pre-Ballet 2: TURQUOISE Level 1: RASPBERRY Level 2: FUCHSIA  
Level 3: ULTRAVIOLET Level 4: BRIGHT RED Level 5: ROYAL BLUE Level 6: HUNTER  
GREEN Level 7: MAROON Level 8+: BLACK

**\*Please do not purchase your color-specific leotard until your Fall ballet level is certain\***

**Boys Ballet:** White or black shirt, black tights/leggings, black ballet shoes.

**Hip Hop:** Girls and boys- any style of top/shorts, and clean sneakers or boots

**Level One and Up Jazz, Tap, Combo Classes, & Other:** Girls' attire is any color, however attire must be tight-fitting to the body with leggings or shorts, and a leotard/dance top. Tan jazz shoes are recommended especially if taking class in the Fall. "Pirouettes" may be worn in class at dancer's discretion. Tap shoes should be black. Boys may choose to wear dance attire OR more loose-fitting t-shirts, tank tops, shorts or pants, any color, with correct shoes.

**RAD Ballet Classes:** RAD specified leotards, tights, and character shoes are required for examination. This information will be provided to all RAD students by Ms. Ana. Students may wear their TADA or RAD uniforms for RAD classes.
