FINANCIAL POLICIES: Access to your account & billing information can be found on your PARENT PORTAL, accessible only with the valid email address you provide at registration. Bank draft required for payment; checks acceptable. Cash payments WILL NOT be accepted. If bank draft is rejected, the credit card on file will be processed along with a \$35 returned check fee. Higher registration fee applies to customers paying yearly tuition via credit card. If a customer changes to credit card payments, the registration fee difference will apply. All payments are non-refundable and non-transferrable. Tuition is divided into 10 equal installments over one school year, August thru May, due on the 1st of each month based on a min of 30 active weeks classes will be in session due to holidays, breaks, inclement weather, and other interruptions. Tuition does not vary or pro-rate even in the event of absences, holidays, days in the month, etc. and TADA follows school calendars for closures, some exceptions. Missed classes can be made up with office permission within 2 weeks of the missed class; no refunds for missed classes. Dropping a class must be done in writing 30 days in advance, otherwise tuition will be charged on the 1st of that month. Class changes after registration will incur a change fee of \$20. Payments made AFTER the 3rd will incur a late fee of \$15, and a \$35 fee will be applied to all returned checks. Late pick up fee is \$1/minute if a child is not picked up within 5 minutes after class. TADA reserves the right to cancel/change a class due to enrollment of less than 5 students.

DRESS CODE:

Creative Ballet and Combo Classes for Ages 6 and under : Pink leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, or black tap/jazz shoe if required, hair in a bun.

*If class has ballet and jazz, ballet shoes may be worn for entire class.

Ages 6+ classes, open classes, etc : All-black attire. For ballet, black leotard and pink tights, pink ballet shoes with hair in a bun. For jazz, tap, etc, tight-fitting black dance top and leggings/shorts. Black jazz/tap shoes. *If class has both ballet and jazz, ballet shoes may be worn for entire class.

Boys: white or black tank or shirt, black leggings/tights, black shoes, with the exception of hip hop

Hip Hop only: Girls and boys- any style and color of top/shorts, and clean sneakers or boots

STUDIO POLICIES: Know before you register. In order to preserve the harmony and safety of the studio and our families, TADA reserves the right to drop a student from a class, or a family from the studio for actions that work in opposition to our studio policies:

- The studio communicates primarily via email - parents must have a valid email address on file in order to receive vital updates and studio info, also distributed via website and social media.
- Age requirements for each class are as of September 1st, 2019; we do this to keep things fair and to keep uniformity across age/maturity/ability levels.
- All recreational classes will participate in the end-of-year informal performance, with the exception of pro/advanced/team classes, leaps/turns, and other higher level classes.
- Students will be accepted into a class at the teacher's discretion or evaluation based on capability, technical level, attention span, and other factors.
- Students must adhere to dress code requirements
- Parents may not leave young children age 6 and under unattended at the studio, and must be present particularly during classes in case of any problems, for restroom use, etc.
- ONLY WATER is allowed in the restrooms and in the dance rooms.
- Make up classes are readily available for missed classes.
- Parents must be sure their child has used the restroom BEFORE class begins.
- During class if a student complains of being ill, or sustains an injury and cannot participate, the instructor or office will notify parents immediately.
- The following are strictly prohibited from the studio: smoking, drugs/illegal substances, weapons, and any other item deemed harmful to the safety and well-being of TADA families.
- TADA reserves the right to drop students from classes or to ask them to leave a class for disruptive behavior, bullying, excessive tardiness and/or absences, or any other harmful conduct, as this negatively affects the quality of education for all students in the classroom.
- Cameras and videotaping in the restrooms and/or dressing areas are strictly prohibited.
- Families must respect the studio by cleaning up after themselves, throwing away trash, etc.
