Please remember the cleanup day April 30. If you have materials from storm damage, you may bring them to the dumpsters at the Community Center. Please contact us to discuss if you have a really large amount of materials, we do want to ensure that this can benefit as many households as possible.

The cleanup event is open to ALL WILDEWOOD RESIDENTS. Proof of residency in the form of a driver's license or electric or water bill with a Wildewood address will be required. If you received this email and do not live at your Wildewood property, please share this information with the residents who live in Wildewood, they are welcome to bring items.

This cleanup is intended to help Wildewood residents properly dispose of items too large or not appropriate for normal household trash pickup. Please continue to dispose of your household trash with your normal trash contractor and **do not** bring it to the event.

We are working hard to arrange to take as many items as possible. If you have large appliances, such as a washer or dryer or other metal items that you would like removed, please contact Jeff Dudley at

903-515-9235 as he may be able to pick them up directly from you, so they don't have to be moved to the community center.

If you have tires from cars or pickup trucks (NOT large equipment tires) that need to be disposed of, they can go to the recycle center in Tyler for a charge of \$5.00. **No tires in dumpster! First tire per family no charge, additional tires \$5.00.** 

**Items such as batteries and wet cans of paint cannot be accepted.** If you have latex paints, you can dry the paint by leaving the can open if there is a small amount or by mixing equal amounts of kitty litter into the paint and allowing it to dry. Dry paint cans will be accepted.

If you are not able to clean up items on your property yourself and would like to ask for assistance from volunteers, or you are able to help those who need assistance, please contact us. Volunteers needed! Please help with cleanup if you can!
