
GOD "Tell me more. I am listening."

Why do believers use the Bible as evidence that God is real?

SCRIBE

It seems counterproductive to use the Bible to prove God is real. So why do we do that?

- *The Bible has wisdom regardless if you are a believer or not.
- *Faith comes from hearing the message and then deciding if it is the truth. If you do not hear, you cannot make an informed decision.
- *The Bible has been proven reliable due to its historical facts and being accurately recorded.

The Bible is not just one source. Since it is a collection of 66 books by at least 40 authors, multiple sources are being cited. Ultimately, the Bible will be just one piece of the puzzle. Many factors will determine if you accept or reject God: experiences, nature, facts, others' stories, unexplained events, a small still voice and history are just some of the evidence you will sift through to make a decision.

Evidence for Authenticity of the Bible

- 1. The Bible was written over a period of about 1500 years by at least 40 authors. Several of these writers provided eyewitness accounts to events. Matthew, Mark, Luke and John were written by men who knew Jesus. Paul wrote several books of the New Testament. He saw Jesus after the Lord's resurrection.
- 2. Among works of antiquity, the Bible has the greatest number of ancient manuscripts found. The New Testament alone has over 5000 manuscripts. Whereas the Iliad has 700 copies and only a handful of Aristotle's writings exist.

- 3. Although variants were found between manuscripts, the Bible has been accurately transmitted. The text we have today is very close to the original manuscript.
- 4. Archaeology has confirmed scripture.
- There is scientific knowledge mentioned in the Bible that was beyond what was known when the authors were alive such as knowing the Earth was spherical.
- 6. There are over 2500 prophecies in the Bible. About 2000 have already come true. The other 500 prophecies are being fulfilled now or will be in the future.

All biblical citations are from the New International Version (NIV) unless cited otherwise. Whenever one verse is isolated, it loses its context. To get a truer meaning, reading whole passages will provide a better reference

ABORTION

SCRIBE

Beliefs about abortion vary drastically from one end of the spectrum to the other. Perhaps instead of concentrating on how we differ, we could find common ground. We could agree that education and prevention are preferable to abortion. A mother's life should be saved when there is no hope of saving the child. Late term abortions are unnecessary since the child and mother can both survive in the third trimester. However, the most powerful way we can help is to provide resources and withhold judgment. We can love and not judge those who are suffering.

God allows free choice not abuse. How can a loving God allow children to be hurt? He does not. It is men and women who choose evil. It is God that heals. It is God that turns what men meant for harm into good. God weeps at what others have done to his children. We are his hands and feet. We must be the ones that protect our innocent young. Become aware of the signs of abuse. Supervise your children. Talk to them about good and bad touch. Explain that they can tell you anything even if someone threatens to hurt them or the family if they tell. Report abuse to social services. Silence is the same as approval. Believe the children. Seldom do they lie about abuse.

- 4. Child does not receive medical care for injuries

Emotional Abuse Signs

- 1. Not interested in what is going on around them

- 4. Acts more angry, fearful or sad than normal
- 5. Does not do well in school
- 6. Hurts self on purpose

Sexual Abuse Signs

- 1. Does not want to go to the bathroom

- 3. Discharge from vagina or penis
- 4. Bleeds through pants
- 5. Sexual knowledge beyond age level
- 6. Running away from home
- 7. Attempting suicide

God's timing was certainly different than mine.

My heart hurts for every person who prayed for healing and did not receive it. Babies with AIDS and young moms with cancer are enough to turn us from God. It is my belief that God always heals. However, it isn't always during this life. He uses doctors, miracles, time and sometimes he heals us after death.

A river of tears and years of prayers have not always changed infertility, single status or abusive loved ones. Does prayer work? In my life, it did not always change the circumstances. However, prayer has brought peace, learning opportunities and open communication with God. For me, that makes it successful.

WORDLY EVIDENCE

*Richard Deem in his article "Scientific Evidence for Answered Prayer and the Existence of God" cited studies about prayer and healing.

The first study Deem explored came from the paper "Positive Therapeutic Effects of Intercessory Prayer in a Coronary Care Unit Population".

Patients in a cardiac unit were randomly placed into two groups. One group received intercessory prayer and one group did not. The prayer team members were born again Christians who daily prayed and attended church. Neither patients nor doctors knew who were receiving prayer.

Deem stated, "Statistics were acquired from the prayer and placebo groups both before and after prayer, until the patients were discharged from the hospital. There were no statistical differences between the placebo and the prayer groups *before* prayer was initiated. The results demonstrated that patients who were prayed for suffered "less congestive heart failure, required less diuretic and antibiotic therapy, had fewer episodes of pneumonia, had fewer cardiac arrests, and were less frequently intubated and ventilated."

Another study Deem cited was "Effects of remote, retroactive intercessory prayer on outcomes in patients with bloodstream infection: randomized controlled trial" 3393 patients with bloodstream infections were involved in the study. Again

there was a control group and a group that had intercessors praying for them.

According to the author of the study, "Remote, retroactive intercessory prayer said for a group is associated with a shorter stay in hospital and shorter duration of fever in patients with a bloodstream infection and should be considered for use in clinical practice."

The final study used different techniques. A third of the patients knew someone was praying for them. A third of the patients, someone prayed for them but did not know it. A third of the patients did not receive prayer. The intercessors were given a script and not allowed to pray what they wanted to say. This study showed no difference between the groups that did not know if they received prayers. However, the group that knew they had intercessors did worse. It is thought that the lack of efficacy for the intercessors affected the results.


