FAQ's (Information for Models)

Working with talented individuals is at the heart of Diamond Life. We value our models' safety and protect their interests, welcoming talent from all walks of life. This sheet is designed to answer common questions regarding consultations, photoshoots, wardrobe, and payment.

Model Safety & Protocols

Model safety and satisfaction are our top priorities. Our lead photographer brings over 25 years of experience, having conducted hundreds of successful photoshoots with over 150 models of diverse backgrounds without incident.

- **Initial Sessions:** First-time shoots with new models are typically held outdoors on location in a public place.
- **Pre-Shoot Consultation:** We meet in a neutral public place to discuss the session details, image types, location, and pricing. The model defines their own comfort levels and has the right to define their working conditions.
- **Verification:** We exchange IDs and sign contracts before beginning; models are encouraged to photograph the photographer's driver's license to share with trusted contacts.
- **Escorts:** Models may bring one friend or family member as an escort, provided they do not interfere with the session. The photographer retains the right to approve all escorts.
- **Security:** For the protection of both parties, all indoor sessions where the model and photographer are working alone are videoed for security reasons.
- **Session Types:** Sessions may either be commercial (visible to others) and private (confidential). Models will receive a different contract depending on the type of session they select, specifying how the images may be used. Images from commercial sessions may be visible to others, but images from private sessions will remain confidential. Diamond Life will not post, publish, or release private session images without the model's knowledge and consent.

Timeliness & Wardrobe

- **Preparation:** Models should arrive at photoshoots dressed (including hair and makeup) and ready to shoot.

- **Outfits:** Please bring a minimum of 2 or 3 different outfits. Specific wardrobe choices should be coordinated with the photographer in advance.
- **Attendance:** A 15-minute grace period is provided for late arrivals before the photographer cancels the session.

Modeling Categories & Standard Rates

Diamond Life pays models for their services at the conclusion of every photoshoot. For in-house development work (portfolios and promos), we utilize the following standard hourly rates based on our specialized categories:

Category	Typical Session Duration	Hourly Rate
Style & Fashion (Fashion, Editorial, Commercial)	60–90 Minutes	\$100
Performance & Motion (Sports, Dance, Fitness)	60–90 Minutes	\$100
Luxury & Intimate (Swimwear)	Up to 2 Hours	\$150
Artistic Expression (Lingerie, Body Paint/Art/Tape)	Up to 2 Hours	\$200
Fine Art (Implied / Tasteful Nude)	Up to 2 Hours	\$300 – \$500

After the Photoshoot

- **Image Delivery:** Models receive a digital gallery of edited images via a download link within 10 days of the session date.
- **Quantity:** Models usually receive up to 100 full-resolution photos, though no specific quantity is guaranteed.
- **Usage Rights:** Diamond Life retains the copyright for all images produced during sessions. Models receive courtesy copies for personal use; models may use the images for their own promotional use (post and share on their social media sites), but the images may not be sold or licensed for profit. If images are used for promotional purposes, Diamond Life requests that you credit the company when sharing images as a professional courtesy.
