
A Reunion of Remembrance: Honoring Our Beloved 65th Veterans 67th Annual Reunion • November 10 − 15, 2021



Twice delayed but never dismayed! Join us at Camp Shelby where it all began – Veterans Day Weekend!

We will conclude our 75th anniversary reunions with a celebration honoring our beloved 65th Veterans with a reunion you will not want to miss. On August 16, 1943, the 65th Infantry Division was activated at Camp Shelby, Mississippi, becoming the first of only two units to be activated at Camp Shelby in its 100-plus year history. Division training began and was conducted over the vast training facilities afforded them at the base. The 65th then departed the base by train beginning on December 26, 1944, at that time, for parts unknown.

The 65th Infantry Division holds an esteemed place in the annals of the history of Camp Shelby. The personnel at the base over the past year have devoted their time and talents to making the 2021 reunion a special event for the Veterans, attendees, and Camp Shelby.

If you have not attended a 65th reunion, then this is the one for you to join us. If you have not attended a reunion in a while, this is the one for you to return to. To all, join us for what we plan to be a reunion you will not forget!

We will again be joined by Veterans of the 71st Infantry Division and their family members as our guests. As you may know the 71st Infantry Division Association has joined us for the past several years. We look forward to having them with us once again this year.

Transportation During the Reunion

Personal cars will be allowed during the reunion *except* for the "Then and Now" base tours. These are guided tours, and the number of participants will be limited per tour. Vans will be provided for these tours. The base

tour will be visiting sites normally not available to the public and personal cars cannot be used.

Personal cars and the vans will be used to travel to and from Hattiesburg for the Veterans Day events (we will caravan to Hattiesburg).

Camp Shelby maps will be provided at registration with places of interest such as the Armed Forces Museum, Base Hotel, All Ranks Club, Base Dining Facility, and the PX are clearly marked.

Wednesday, November 10, 2021: Registration and Informal Get Together

The Executive Board and Reunion Committee encourages everyone to arrive on Wednesday if possible, in anticipation of special Hattiesburg and Camp Shelby Veterans Day 2021 events. Registration: Treasurer Sibyl Ream will be available at 4:00 p.m. in the Base Hotel lobby to provide the information needed for the reunion. During registration you will be asked to sign up for a time for your guided Camp Shelby Base tour and guided Armed Forces Museum tour.

Get Together: 6:00 – 10:00 p.m. we will informally gather at the All Ranks Club located next door to the Base Hotel to say hello and enjoy food and drinks. No reservations are necessary, and the cost of this meal is on your own.

Thursday, November 11, 2021: Hattiesburg and Camp Shelby Veterans Day Events

The 40th annual Hattiesburg Veterans Day parade and commemoration ceremonies will be honoring the 65th and 71st Veterans in downtown Hattiesburg.

Throughout the 100-year history of Camp Shelby, the city of Hattiesburg has been a home away from home for hundreds of thousands of soldiers who have trained at Camp Shelby. They continue that support with their largest parade of the year organized by the local VFW Post. The parade concludes at the Veterans Park in downtown Hattiesburg where commemorative ceremony will be held. The 65th and 71st Veterans will be recognized.

Thursday morning: We depart Camp Shelby via car caravan for Hattiesburg for the parade which will begin at 10:00 a.m. followed by the Veterans Park ceremonies.



Arrangements will be made for lunch for the Veterans and their caregiver. Attendees may enjoy any one of several restaurants in Hattiesburg before returning to Camp Shelby.

Thursday afternoon: Guided Armed Forces Museum tours will be available. This museum has importance special Association because the Association was instrumental in helping make the Museum come to fruition. W.B. "Sandy" Sanders (261HO1) was on the Foundation Board of Directors. Many other 65th Veterans were active with the Museum. In addition to Sandy Sanders, Lynn LaBarre (265A), Jay Piccinati (265A), and John Boesch (765ORD) were long time members of the Association's Camp Shelby Museum Committee.

Thursday Registration: For those attendees who were unable to arrive on Wednesday, late registration will be available on Thursday afternoon.

Thursday Evening Meet and Greet: For first timers and all returning reunion attendees this

will be the perfect time to renew friendships and create a new family of friends. Those who are regular reunion attendees will confirm that we all have an extended family that, until you attend a reunion, you did not know existed—the family of 65th Veterans, their descendants, and extended family members. The Veterans and attendees have always enjoyed a pizza night and we will have Papa John's baking fresh pizzas.

Hospitality: The Base Hotel lobby will serve as the hospitality area and place to visit with each other.

Personal Memorabilia: We invite and encourage everyone to bring your photo albums and any personal memorabilia to share. Sharing memorabilia is always a highlight of the reunions.

Friday, November 12, 2021: "Then and Now" Tour – Camp Shelby as it was then and what it is now.

Since the first site visit to Camp Shelby, the personnel, led by former Special Programs Officer Colonel Mark Prine (Retired) have been planning a base tour that will encompass sites dating back to the base's early years of World War I through its varied missions today. Over the past several months the has experienced significant construction. As a result of this construction, sites dating back to World War I and II have been discovered. The archivists at the base are being notified and they have discovered and documented interesting some sites significance—some important to the time when the 65th was at the base.

At the time of this writing final details and sites for the tour are not complete, but we can share with you that among some of the WWII and 65th era sites we will visit are the 65th barracks, division commanders housing, departure location where the Division boarded the trains to depart on December 26, 1944, training sites, gym, sand table building, etc. Recently the base informed us that there will be historical markers to identify sites of historical significance.

Camp Shelby is currently serving multi missions continues to serve as a primary training site for National Guard, Reserve, and active-duty units. This also includes training for Allied countries. The base served a significant role in training units during the Middle East conflicts dating back to 1990 prior to Desert Storm. Training facilities, including the National Drone Training Center, Urban Warfare training site, and others will be included in the tour. Some equipment demonstrations are tentatively scheduled for Sunday afternoon.

Transportation for the Base Tours will be provided by vans. We will have approximately 12 attendees per van with a historian as a guide for each group. Lunch will be served at the Base Consolidated Dining Facility. We thought about handing out MRE's

(ready-to-eat meal) and stopping to picnic but thought better of it!

Friday afternoon: After lunch we will convene in the Grand Gallery, Armed Forces Museum, for a two-part session that you will not want to miss.

Award winning documentarian, Kane Farabaugh will preview his documentary "Requiem for a Knight" (working title) which chronicles exploits of the 65th Infantry their heroic Division during across Germany march culminating with the final days of combat and VE Day in Austria. Kane will also be filming during the Reunion of Remembrance. Footage of events and interviews from the reunion will be included in the completed documentary. Tommy Lofton, Director of the Armed Forces Museum, will be the moderator for a discussion among the 65th and 71st Veterans about their personal experiences during the Rhineland and Central Europe Campaigns as well as



their training at Camp Shelby.

Following this session, guided museum tours will be available to those who registered during registration. This also will be a good opportunity to tour the static displays outside the museum on your own.

Friday Evening Mixer: The Friday night mixer will be in the Grand Gallery of the Armed Forces Museum. Given the location of our reunion in the South, we thought a good ol' Southern style barbeque with all the fixins would be a good change of pace. The program for this evening is to be determined. Updates will be posted on Facebook and at 65thdiv.com.

Saturday, November 13, 2021: Remembering the Exploits of the 65th Division and the Men Who Served

The Saturday ceremonies and memorial service as well as a photo session will be memorable for all of us.

The Association extended formal invitations to several dignitaries including government and military officials as well as state veteran's organizations. In addition to the French Consul, or his designee, we expect to be joined by several invitees for the Saturday ceremonies.



Saturday Morning French Legion Honor and of Inactivation Ceremonies: We will literally return to where it all began! All attendees, except for the 65th and 71st Veterans, will return to the museum area (parking will be available around museum). The the honored Veterans and a caregiver will travel by special motorcade to near the museum area, at which time they will be joined by marching units, including a color guard and the 41st Army Band. They will then continue to the Camp Shelby Parade Ground. The Parade Ground is where, on August 16, 1943, the 65th Infantry Division was activated with General Stanley Reinhart in command.

The highlight of the *Reunion of Remembrance* will be the ceremonies commencing on the historic Parade Ground. The Camp Shelby Parade Ground is the same area that has been the site of all significant ceremonies since the very beginning of the base over 100 years ago.

Two of the 65th Veterans, Art Newell (260B) and Norvin McClure (265HQ), have been informed they have been awarded the French Legion of Honor (*Légion d'Honneur*) medal.

Many thanks 65th to Association honorary member, Eric Montgomery, for his continued assistance in helping Veterans attain recognition. Art and Norvin will be presented with the Legion of Honor medal by French Consul General Vincent Hommeril, or his

designee, who is the Republic of France's official overseeing diplomatic duties in the Southeastern Region of the United States. We will also be acknowledging all 65th and 71st Veterans who have previously received this honor.

Immediately following the Legion of Honor presentation, we will reenact the 65th Infantry Division inactivation ceremony that was held on August 31, 1945 in Europe at the same location the 65th activation ceremony was held in 1943. Most of us are aware that the 65th has never been reactivated.

Saturday Lunch: Following the Parade Ground ceremonies we move to the Armed Forces Museum Grand Gallery for lunch. We will be joined by invited dignitaries to thank them for their contributions to the ceremonies and memorial service to follow.

Saturday afternoon Memorial
Service and Wreath Laying
Ceremony: After lunch we will
proceed to the WWII era chapel.
Camp Shelby Post Chaplain
Lieutenant Colonel Antione Barlow
and Barbara DuBois Russell,
Association Corresponding Secretary,
will officiate the memorial service.
This service with music by a brass

ensemble from the 41st Army Band and vocalist will conclude with the Taps ceremony.


At the conclusion of the memorial service, we will proceed to the 65th Infantry Division monument for a wreath laying ceremony, taps, and a missing man flyover by L-Bird airplanes. L-Birds were used during WWII for reconnaissance and as artillery spotters.



The 65th Monument was the first monument to be placed in front of the Armed Forces Museum. The monument was dedicated in September 1984 during the Association's annual reunion held in Hattiesburg.

Screening of "The Greatest Honor": Kane Farabaugh will be hosting a screening of his Emmy

Award winning Documentary, *The Greatest Honor*, featuring 65th Veteran John Amm (260G) and other 65th Veterans. The screening will be in the Grand Gallery.





Saturday evening Gala Banquet: After returning to the Base Hotel or your cabin, you will have some time to rest and prepare for the evening's festivities. At 6:00 p.m. we will gather at the All Ranks Club for cocktails and conclude the day's activities with a gala banquet. The honorees for the evening will be the 65th and 71st Veterans with special recognition of all Veterans who have received the Legion of Honor medals. Music will be provided by a jazz combo from 41st Army Band. The entertainment will be announced at a later date. A cash bar will be available throughout the evening.

Sunday, November 14, 2021: Association Membership Meeting and Camp Shelby Demonstrations

Sunday Morning Membership Meeting:

The 65th Infantry Division Association's annual Membership Meeting will be held in the All Ranks Club. We encourage all to attend this meeting. We hope that if you are not a Legacy member, you will consider becoming one. All may attend; however, voting will be limited to those members in good standing.

Sunday Afternoon Demonstrations:

Camp Shelby has a significant inventory of Abrams tanks as well other Army equipment including **Bradley** fighting vehicles. We will be able to tour a static display of an Abrams tank and a Bradley fighting vehicle. Pending qualified personnel availability, we also hope to have a live fire demonstration of some equipment. Camp Shelby is a National Drone Training Site, and we will be able to see several drones used in training and hopefully be able to have a demonstration.

For those who wish to fire weapons on the Laser Range, a schedule will be arranged during the reunion.

In addition to current military

equipment, Camp Shelby and the Armed Forces Museum has one of the largest vintage military equipment displays in the country.

Additional times for guided Camp Shelby Base and Armed Forces Museum tours may be scheduled if needed.

Sunday Evening Dinner: The All Ranks Club will be open for dinner and will be a relaxing time to share the experiences of the reunion.

Camp Shelby General Information:


- Camp Shelby is located south of Hattiesburg, MS.
- South of the intersection of U.S. 98 and U.S. 49
- South on U.S. Highway 49
- Approximately 60 miles from the Gulfport-Biloxi International (GPT) Airport
- Camp Shelby is ADA compliant.
- The **North Gate** will be the primary entrance to Camp Shelby.
- North Gate address is: 200 Lee Avenue, Hattiesburg, MS.
- The North Gate will be open 24/7 during the reunion. It is not recommended entering the base through any other gate. Directional signage will be erected to assist with locating primary reunion locations. Please see Camp Shelby map.
- Government issued ID (driver's license, passport, etc.) will be necessary to access the base.
- All reunion activities will be on Camp Shelby property with the exception of the Veterans Day activities that will be in downtown Hattiesburg.
- Transportation for the Friday Camp Shelby "Then and Now" tour will be by van. No personal cars will be allowed for this tour.
- Personal and rental cars may be used for all other transportation during the reunion. Carpooling will be necessary at these times.
- Familiarize yourself with the Camp Shelby map that will be provided at registration. Camp Shelby is one of the largest military facilities in the world encompassing approximately 160,000 acres. We don't want anyone to get lost because you might not be found!


