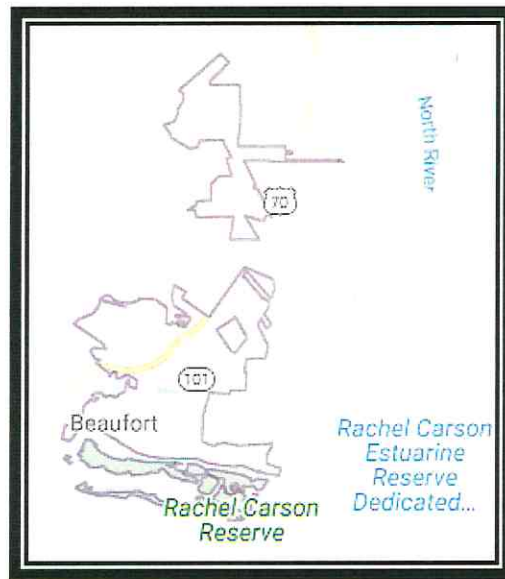

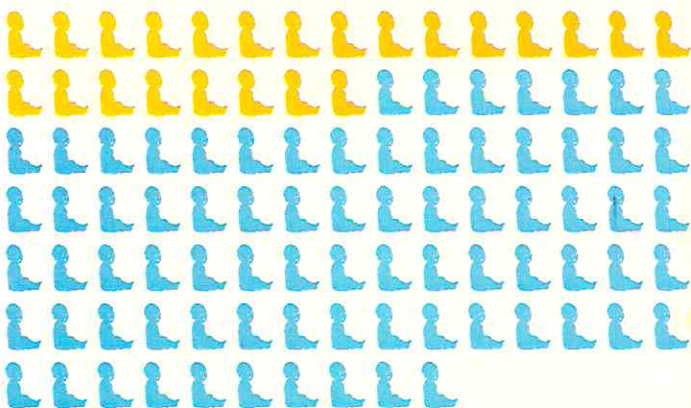

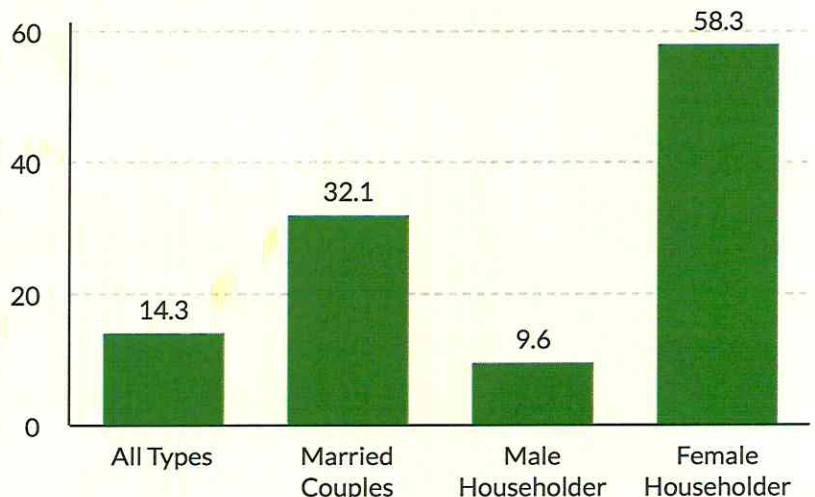


## Poverty Rate for Children Aged 0-4



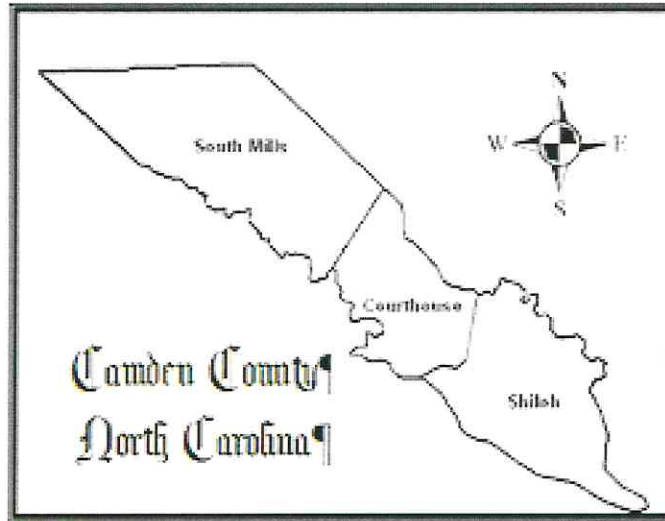

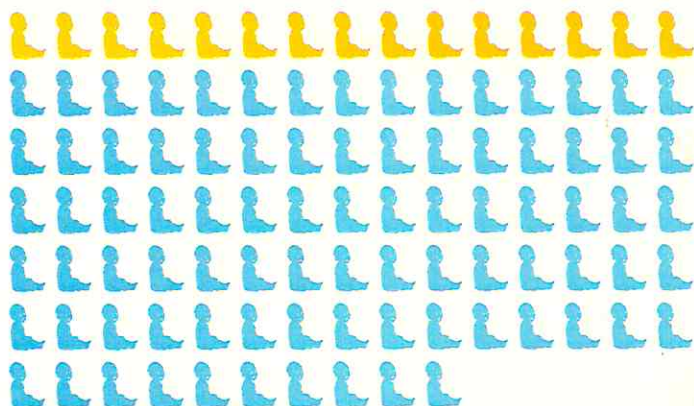

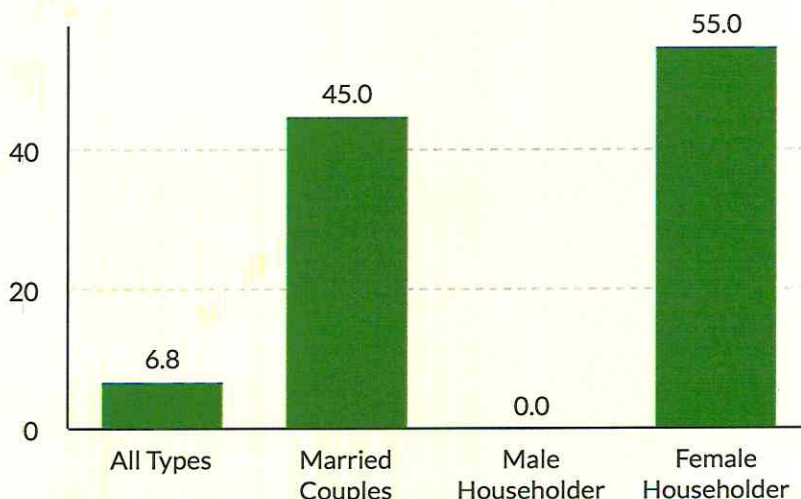


## Poverty Rate for Children Aged 0-4



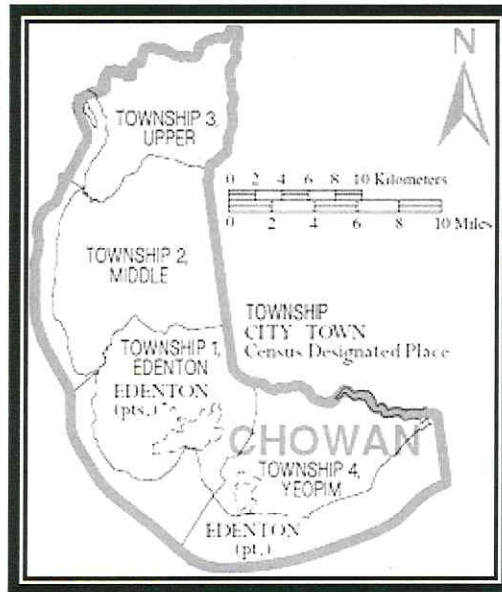

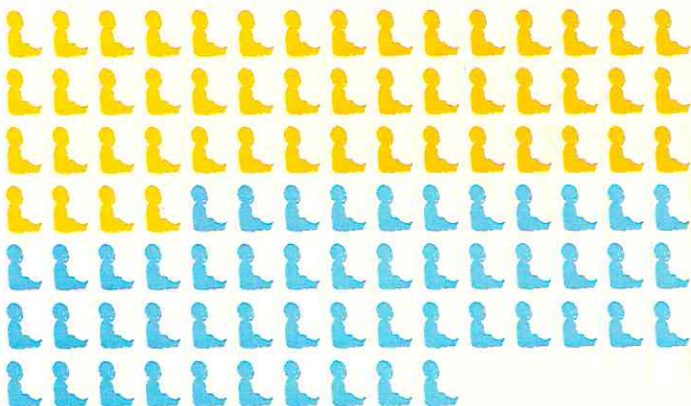

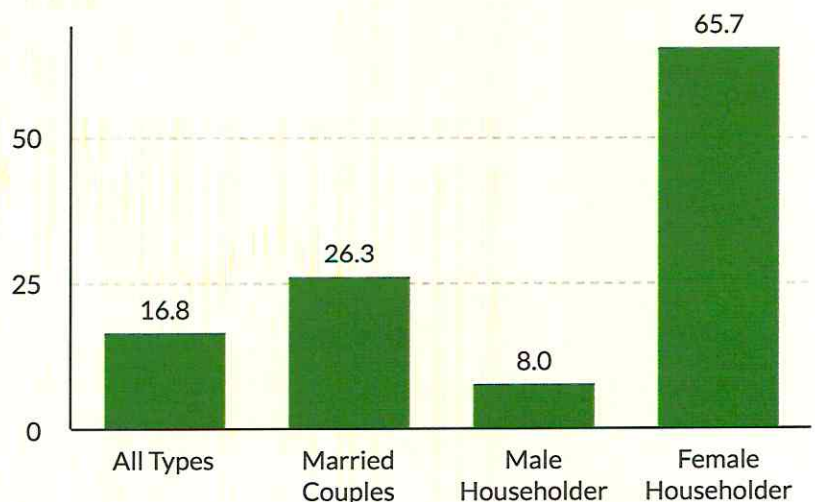


## Poverty Rate for Children Aged 0-4

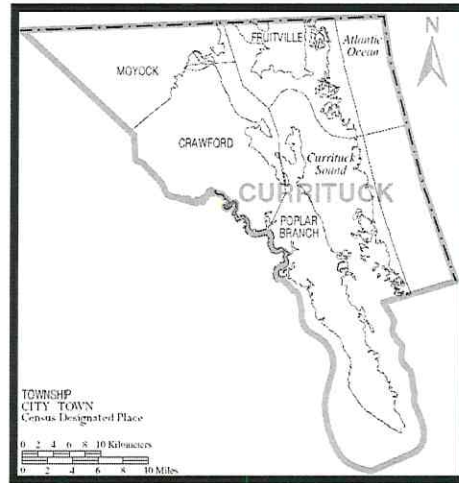
## Poverty Rate (%) by Family Type

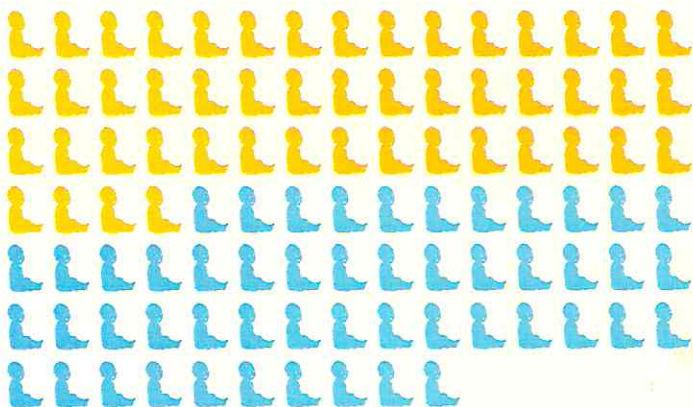

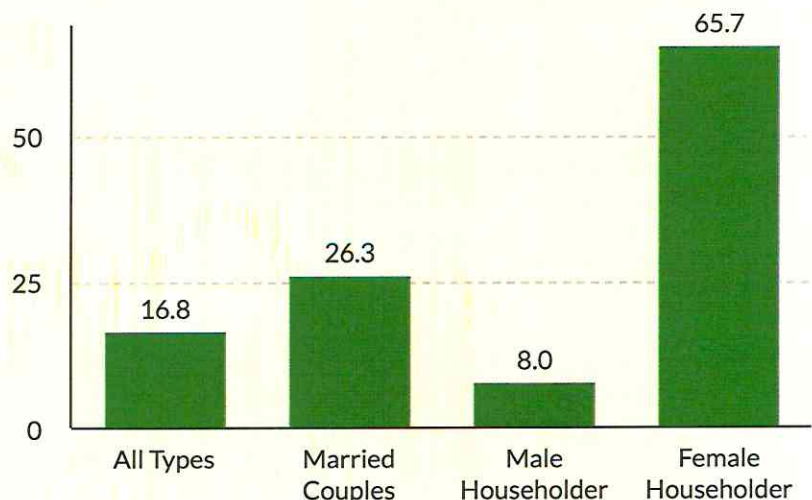


## Poverty Rate for Children Aged 0-4



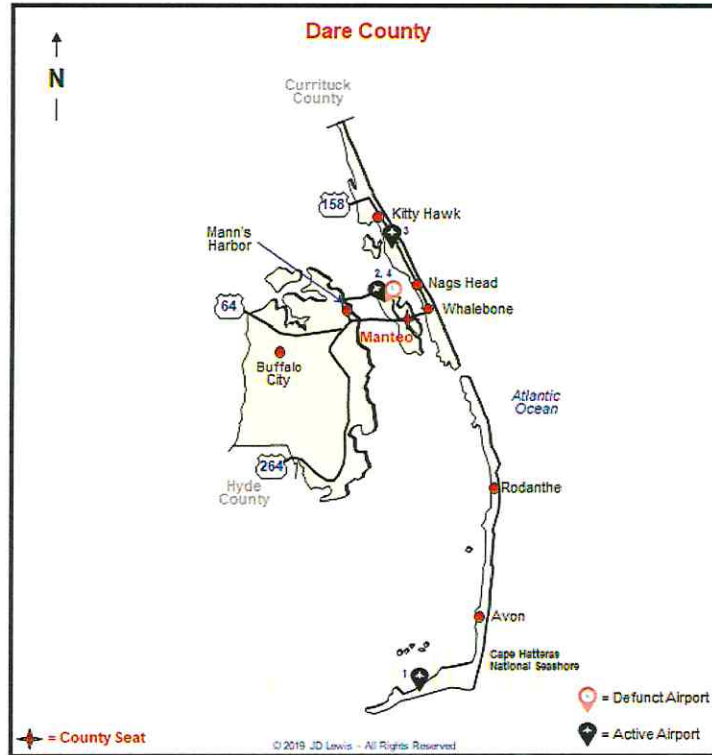

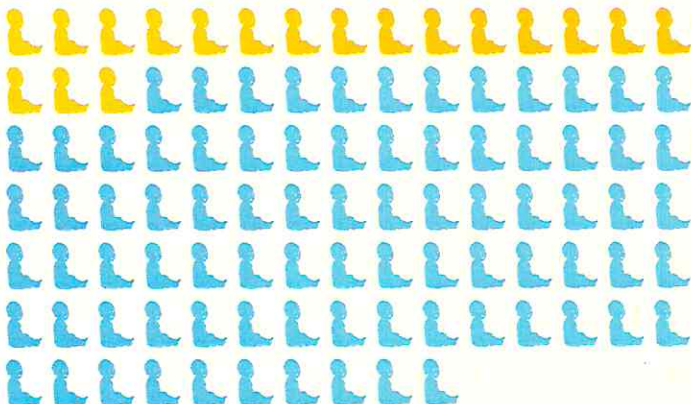

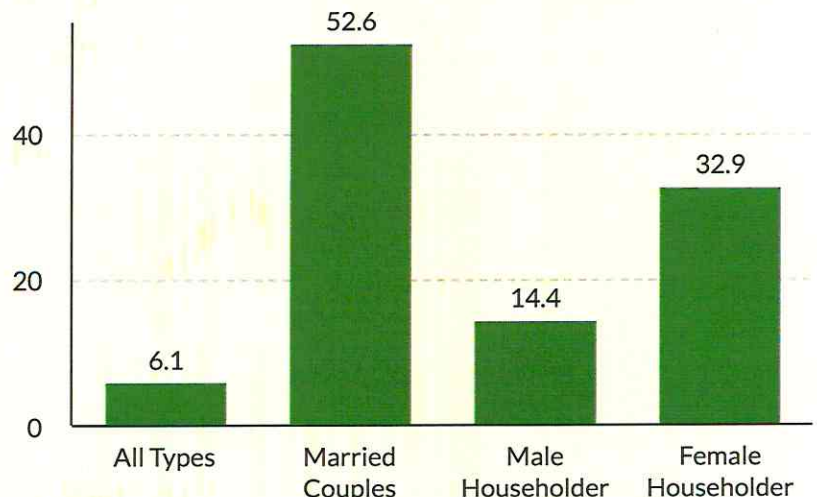


## Poverty Rate for Children Aged 0-4



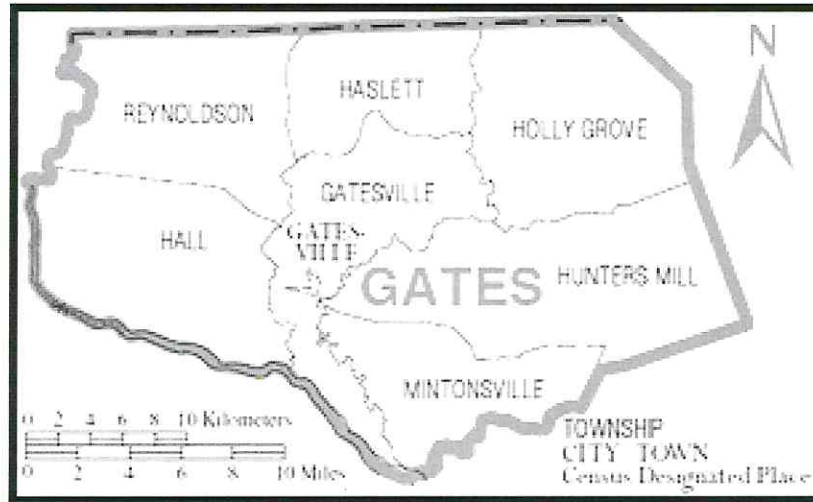

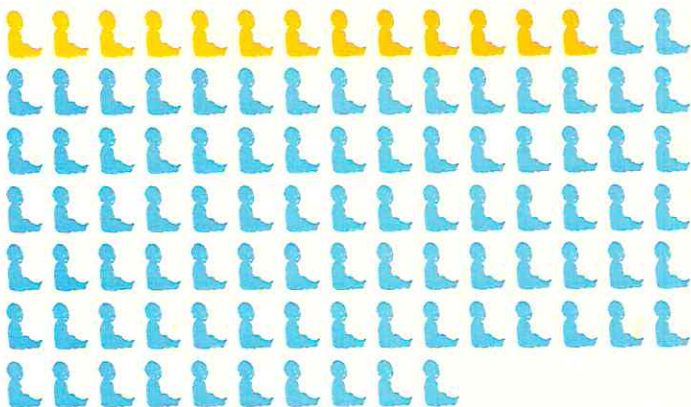

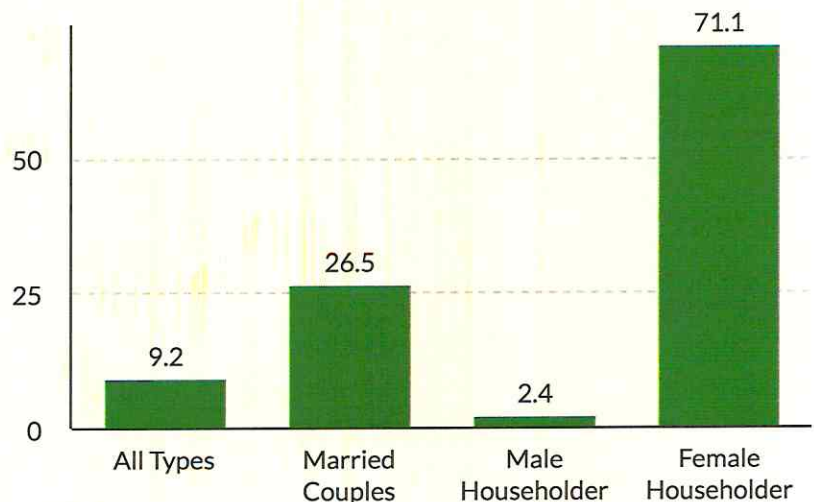


## Poverty Rate for Children Aged 0-4

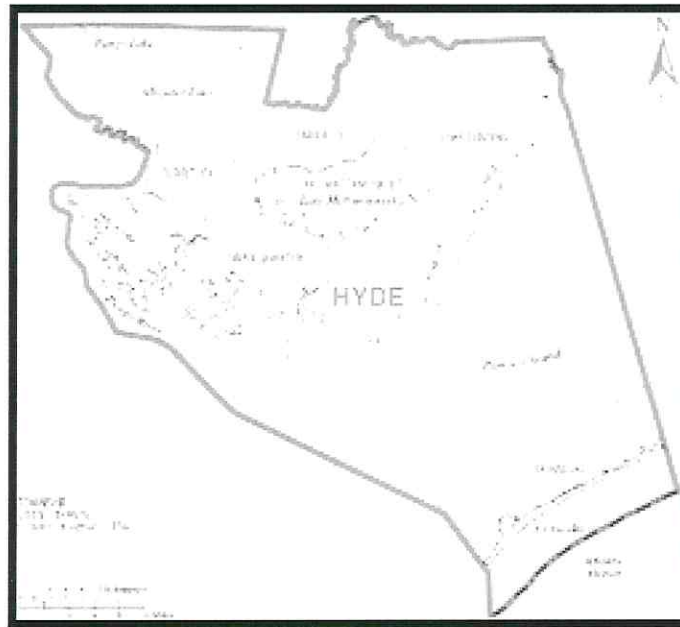

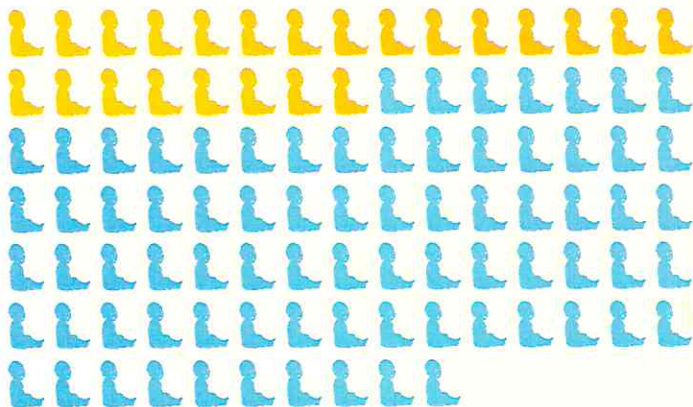

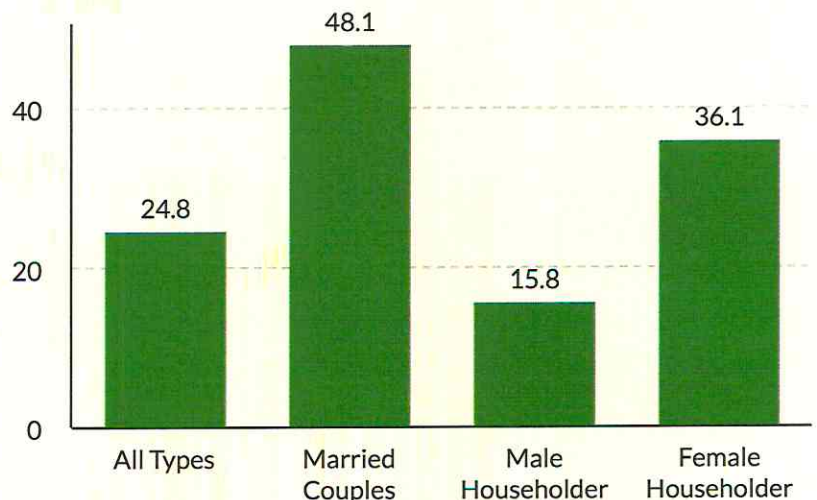


Poverty Rate for Children Aged 0-4



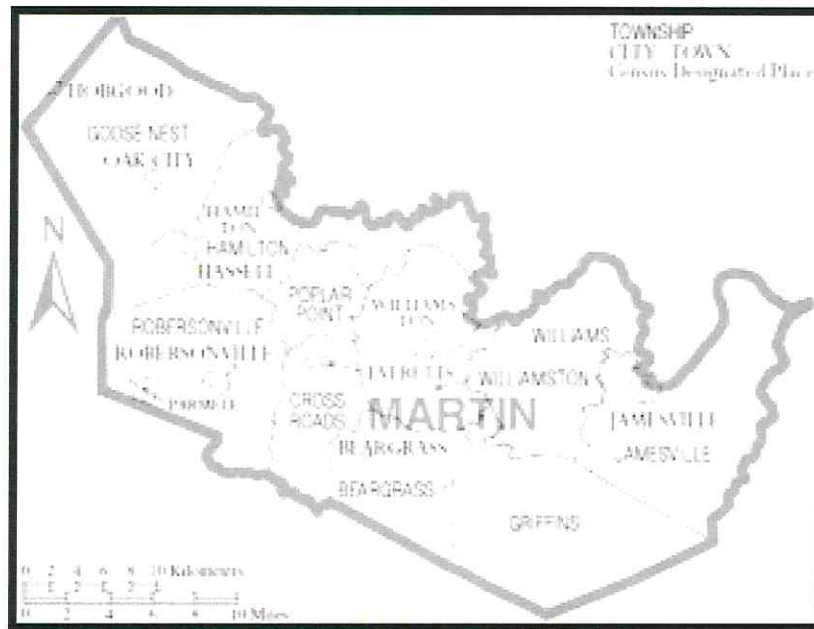

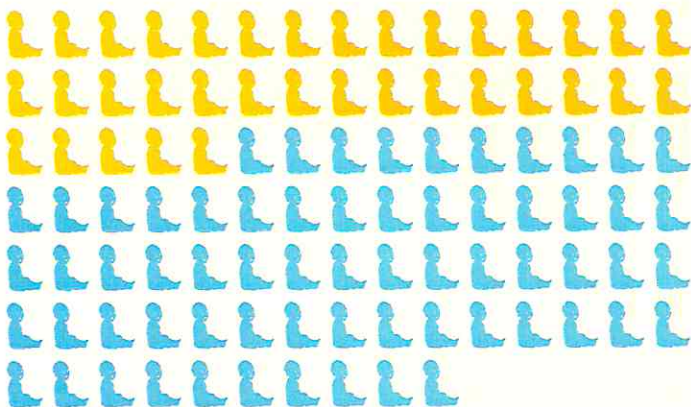

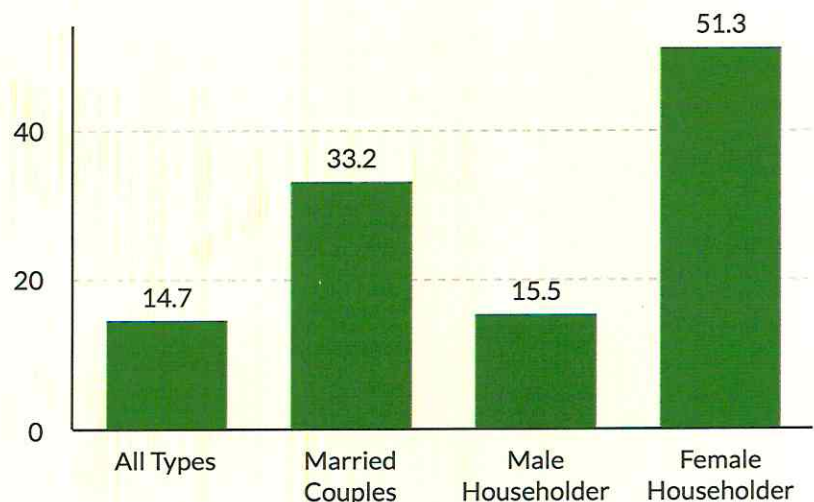


## Poverty Rate for Children Aged 0-4



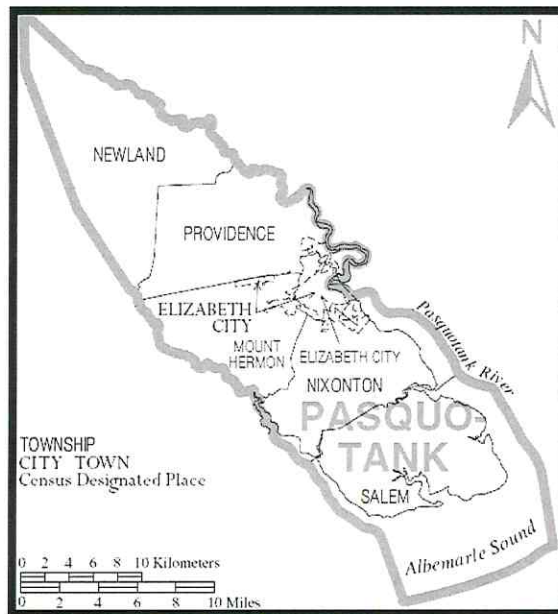

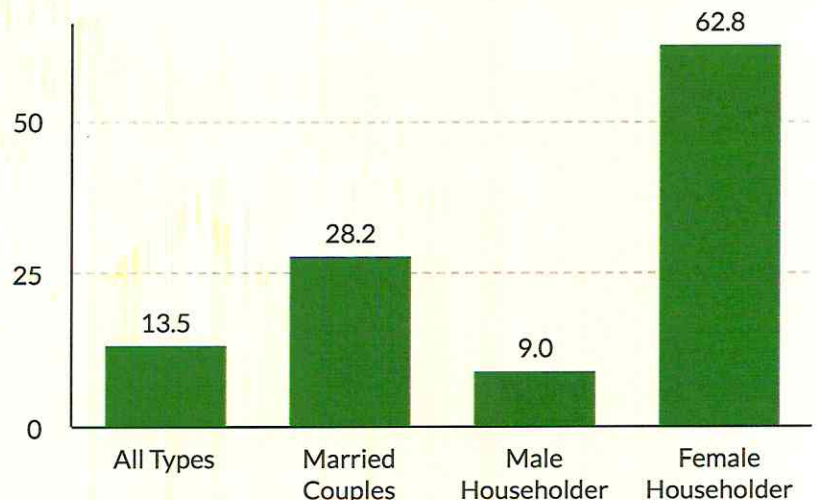


## Poverty Rate for Children Aged 0-4

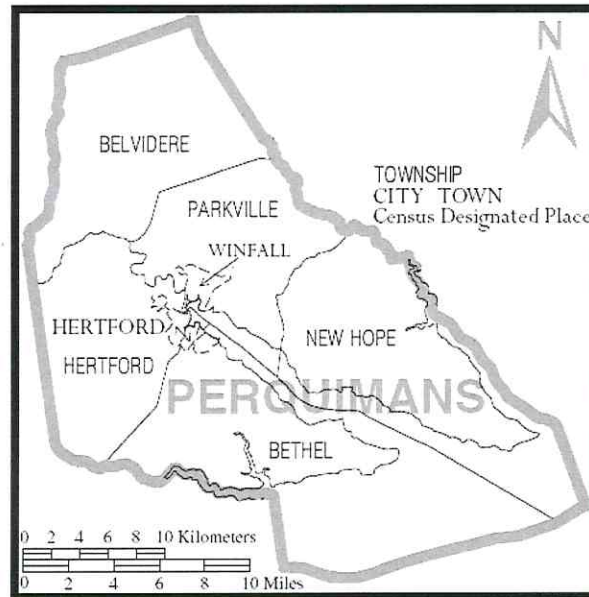

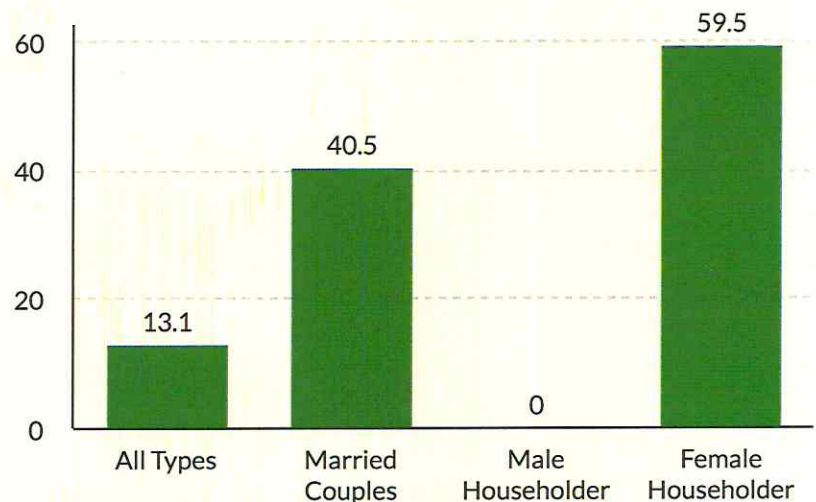

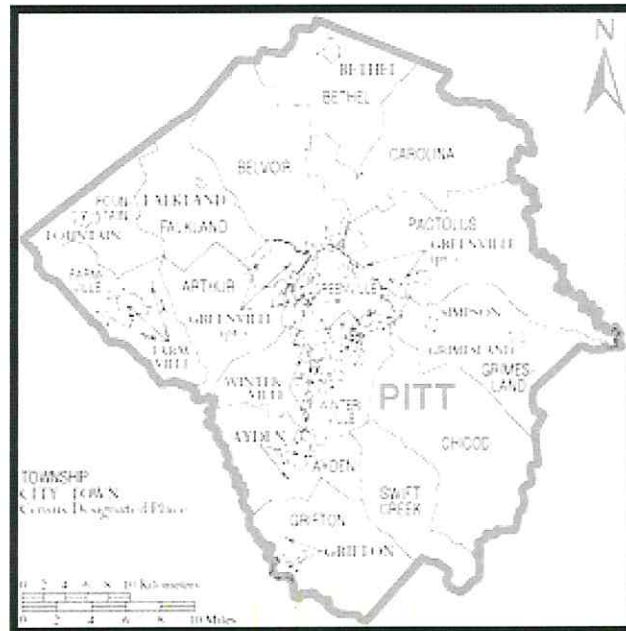

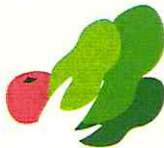

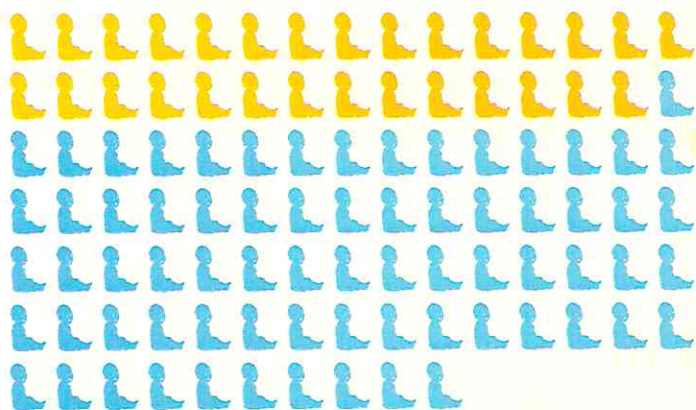

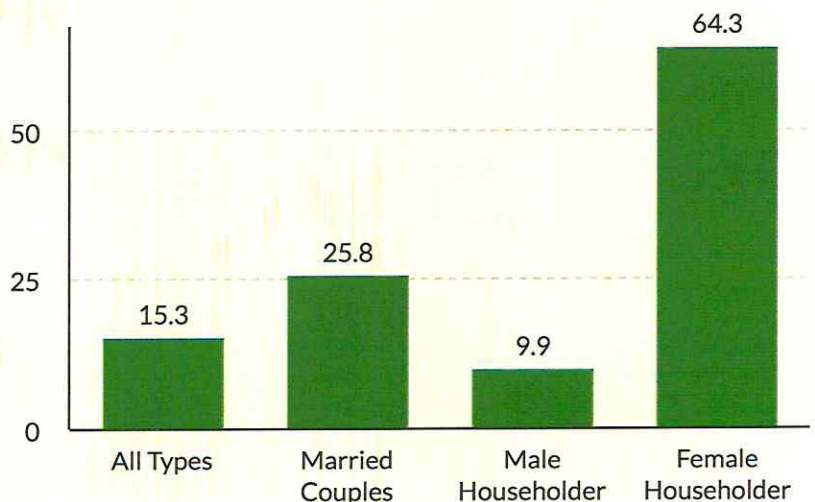


## Poverty Rate for Children Aged 0-4



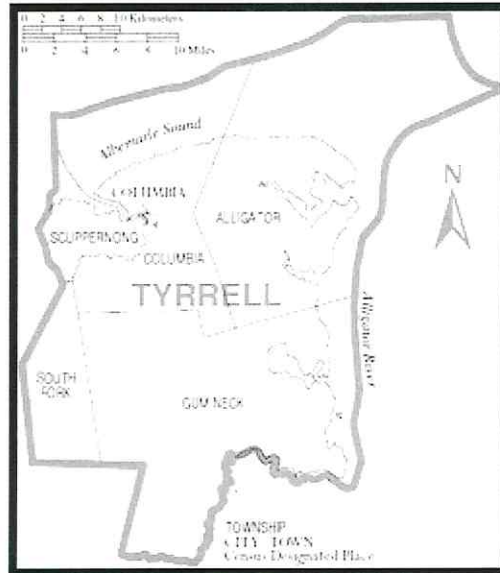

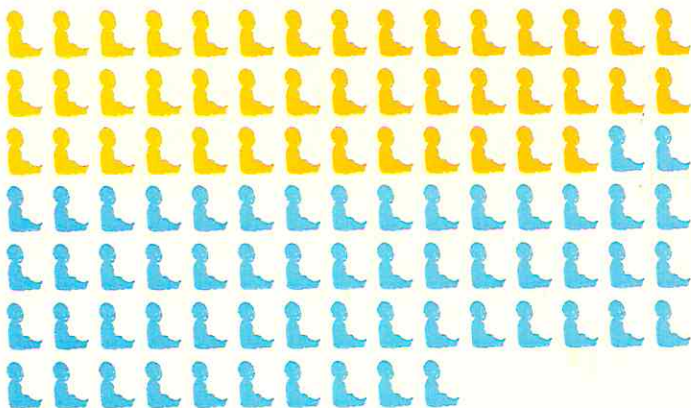

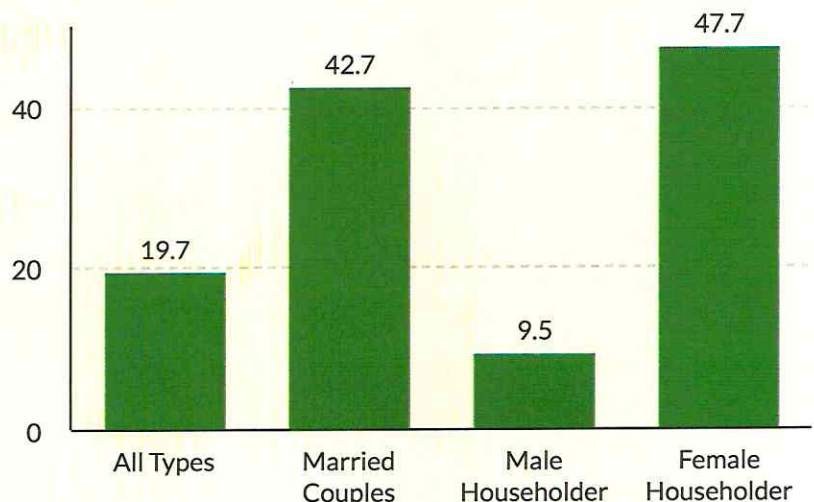


## Poverty Rate for Children Aged 0-4



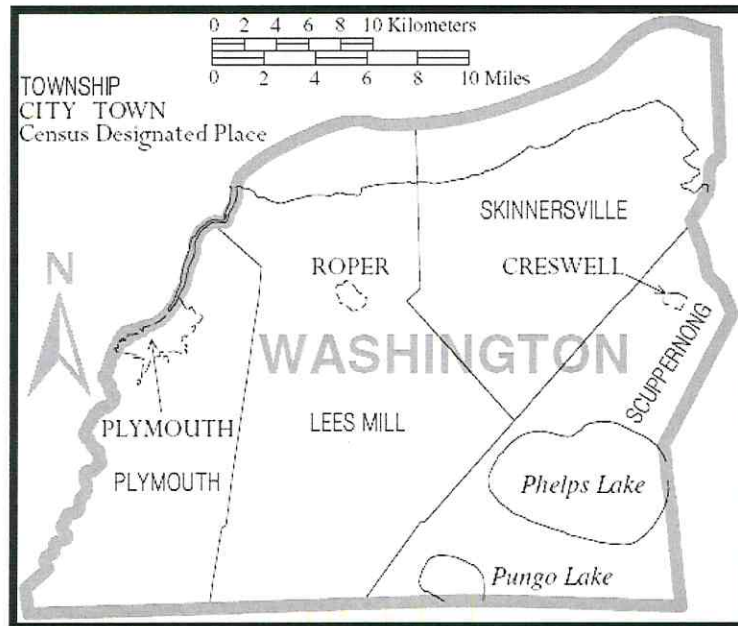

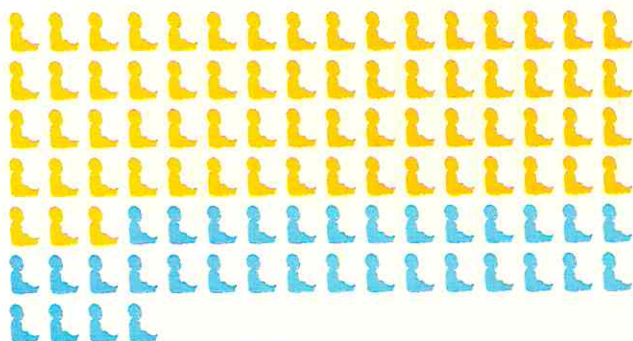
