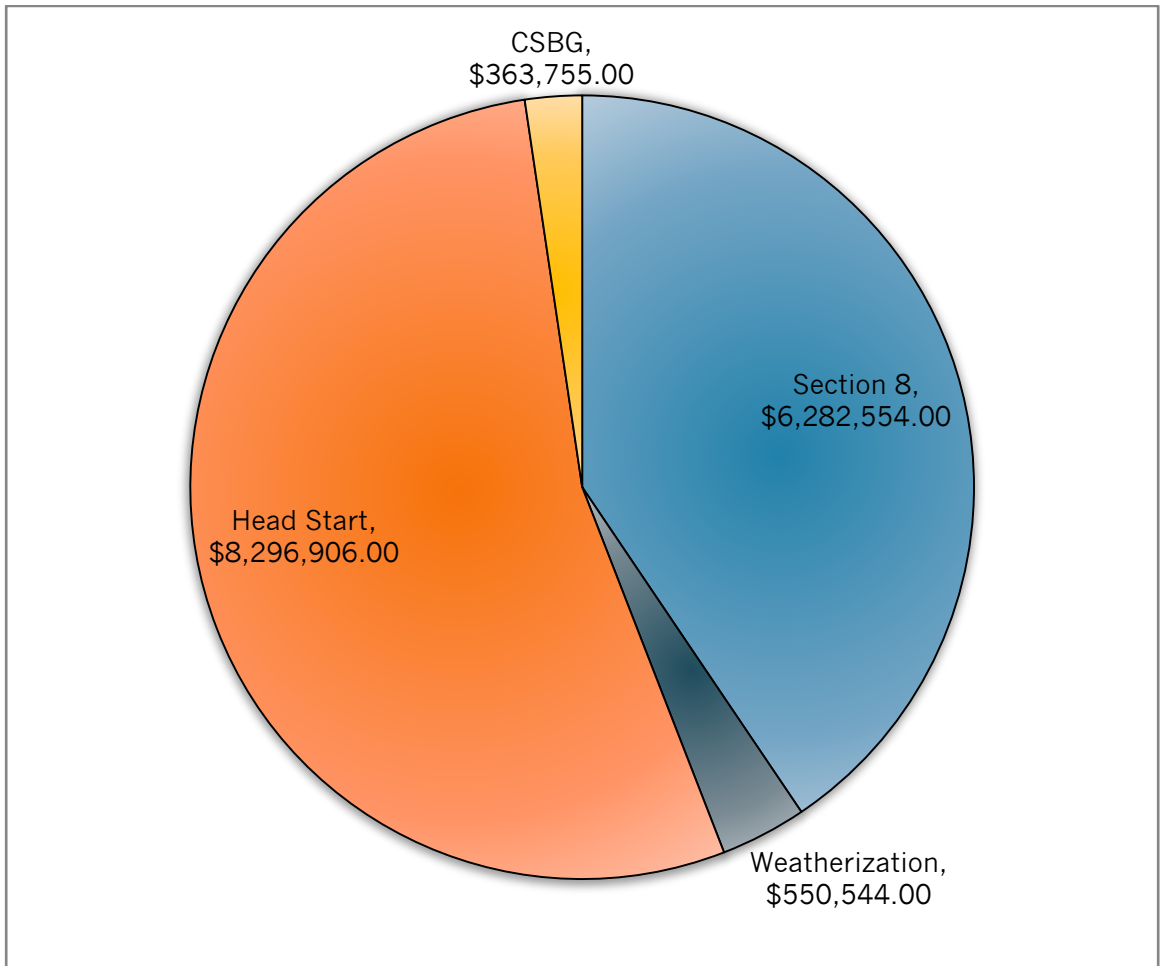

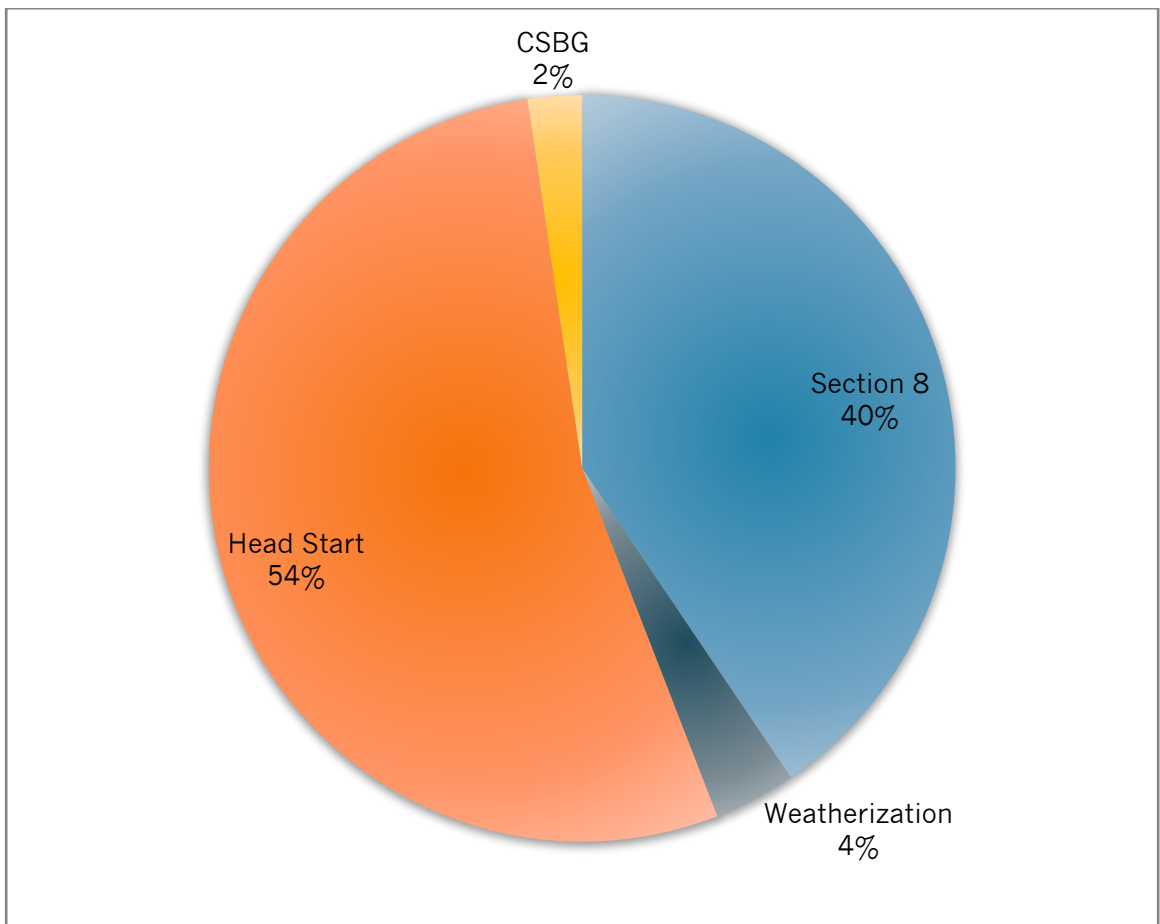


**EIC PROGRAM BUDGET

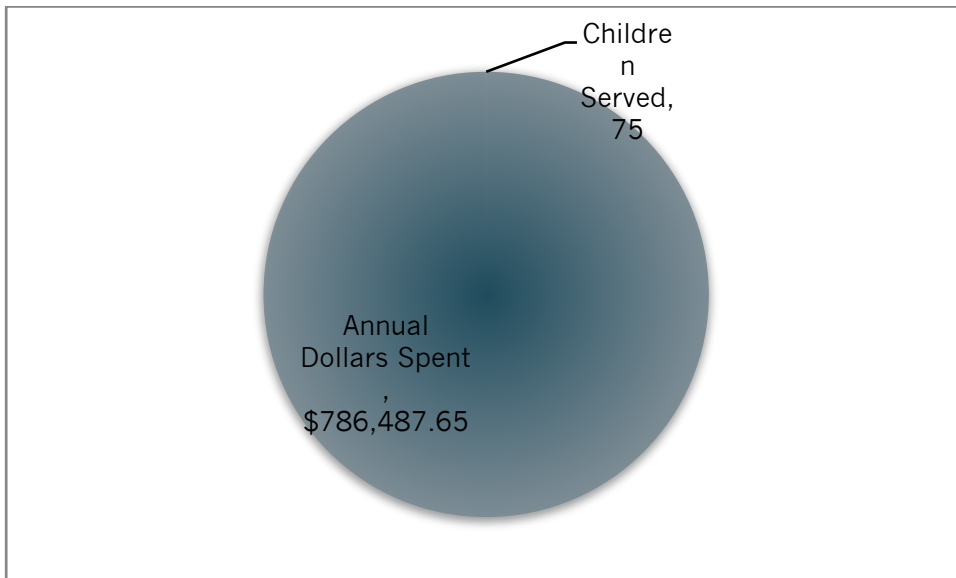

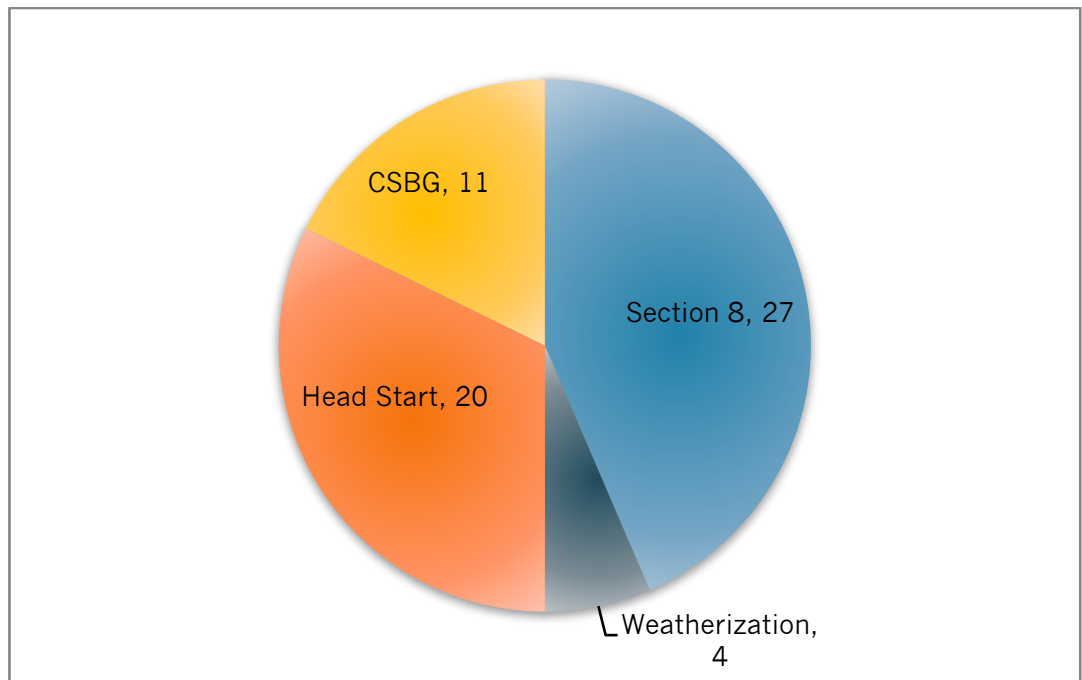

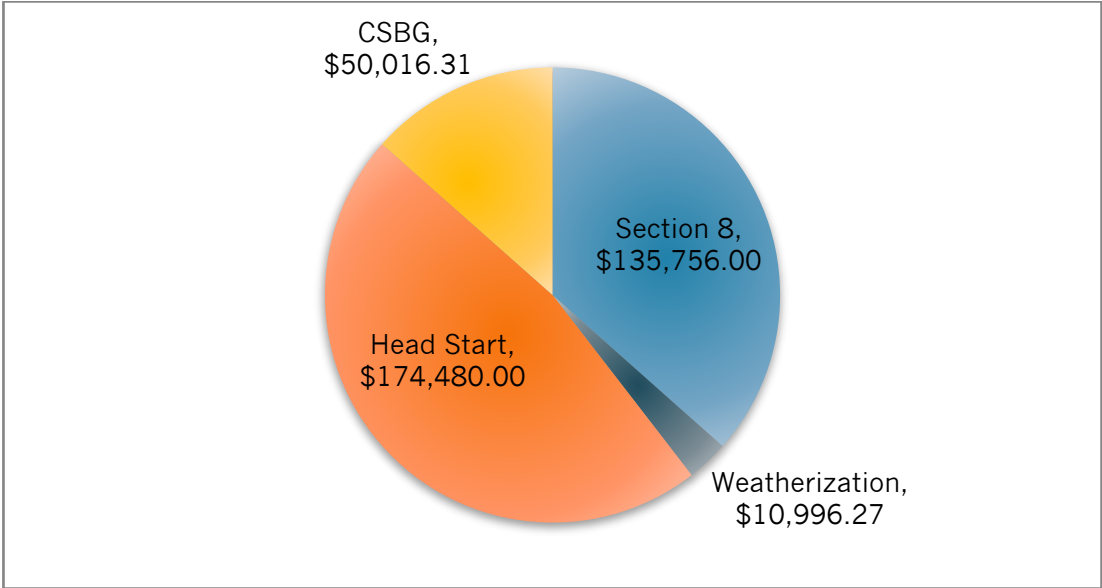

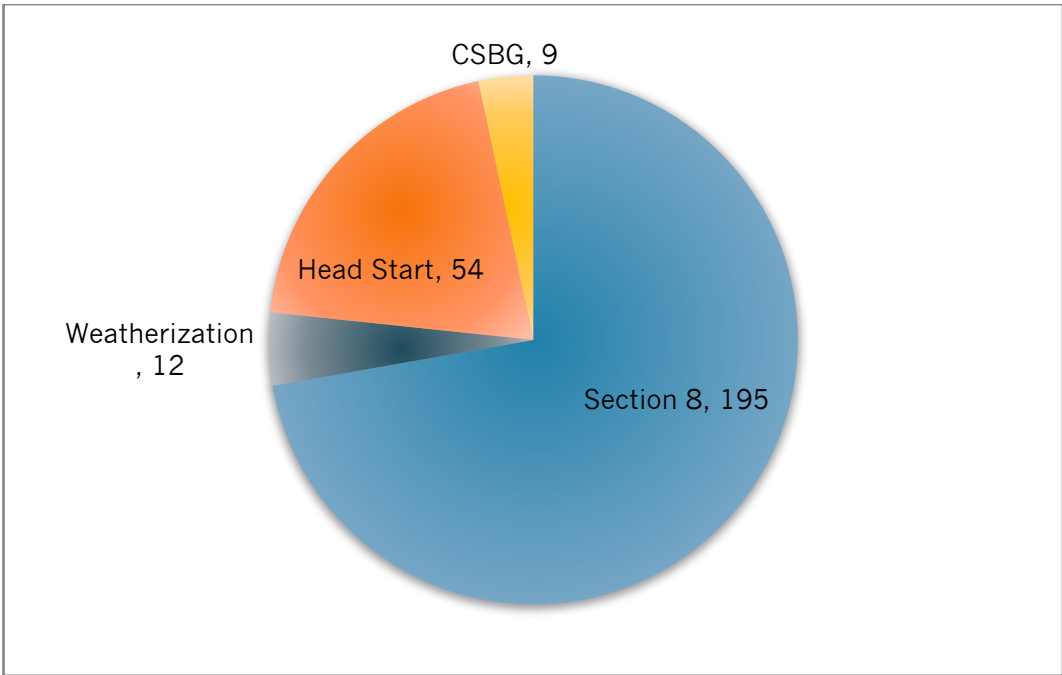

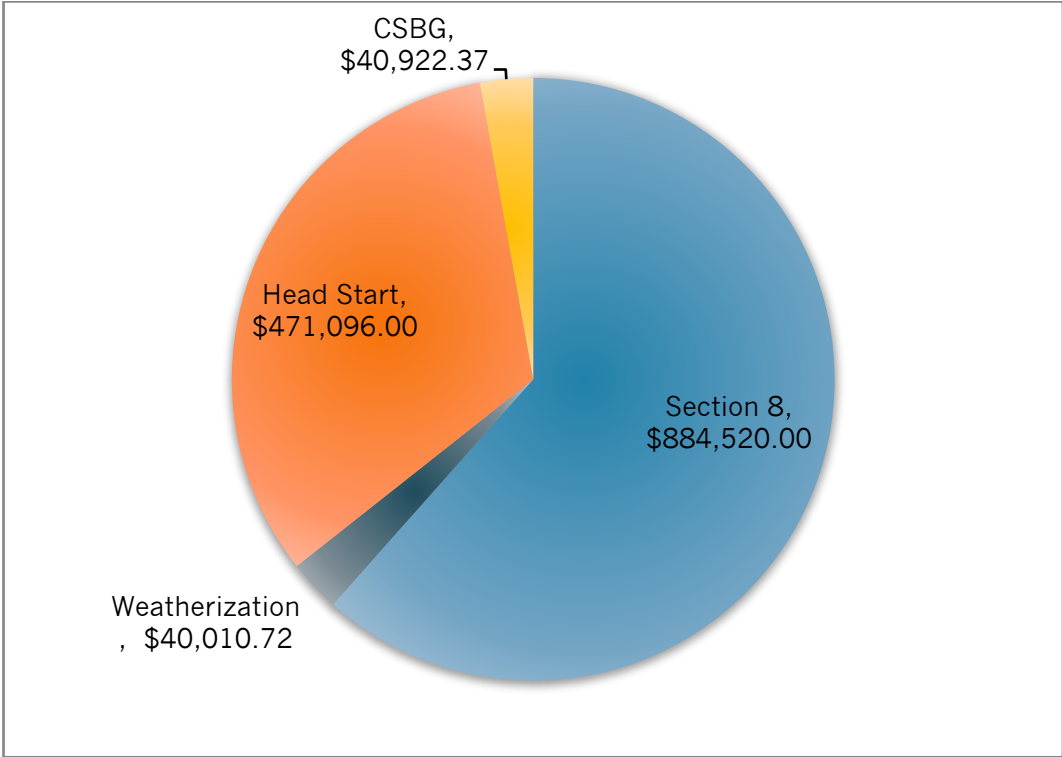

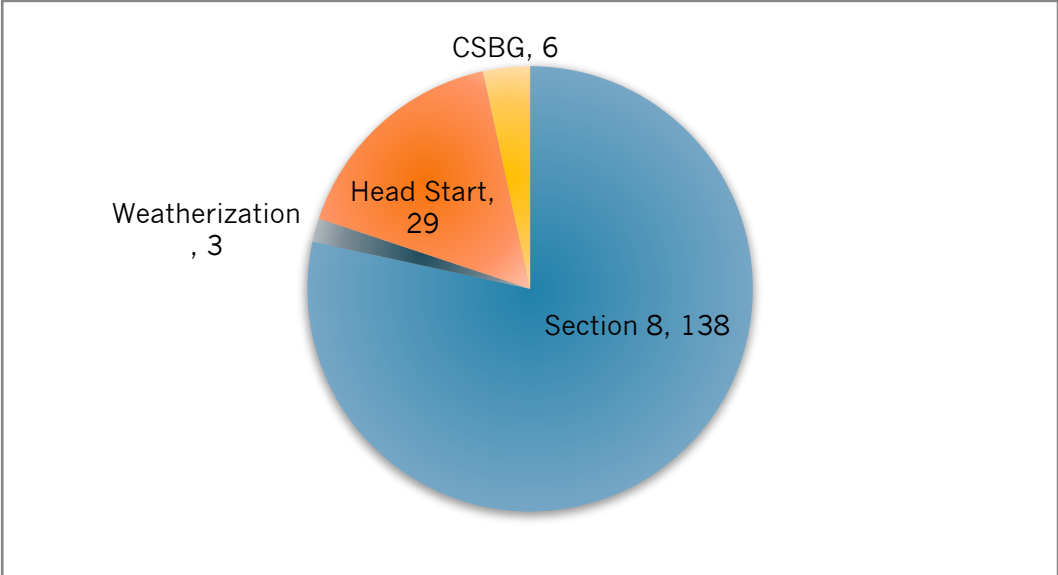

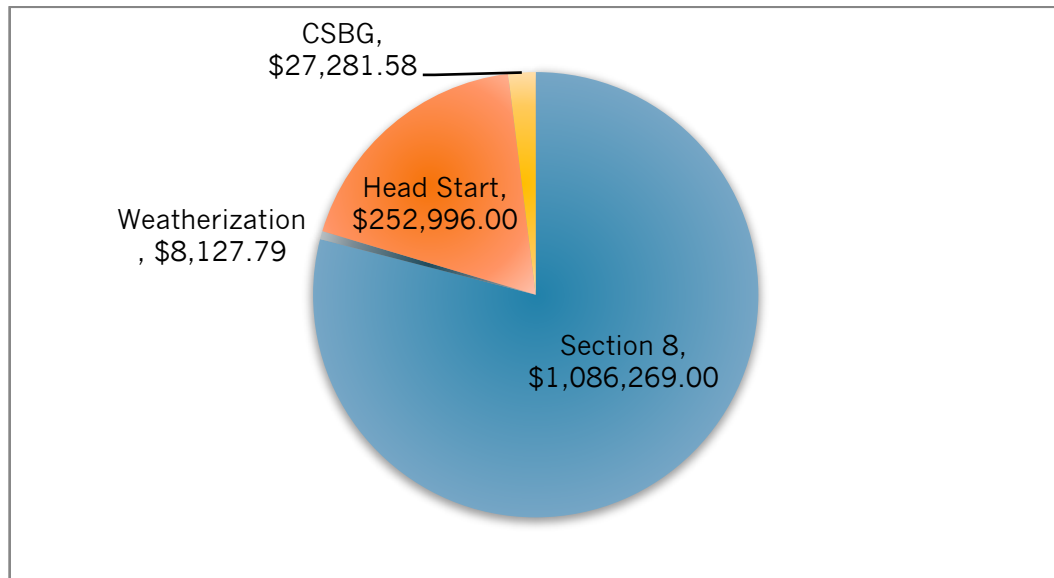

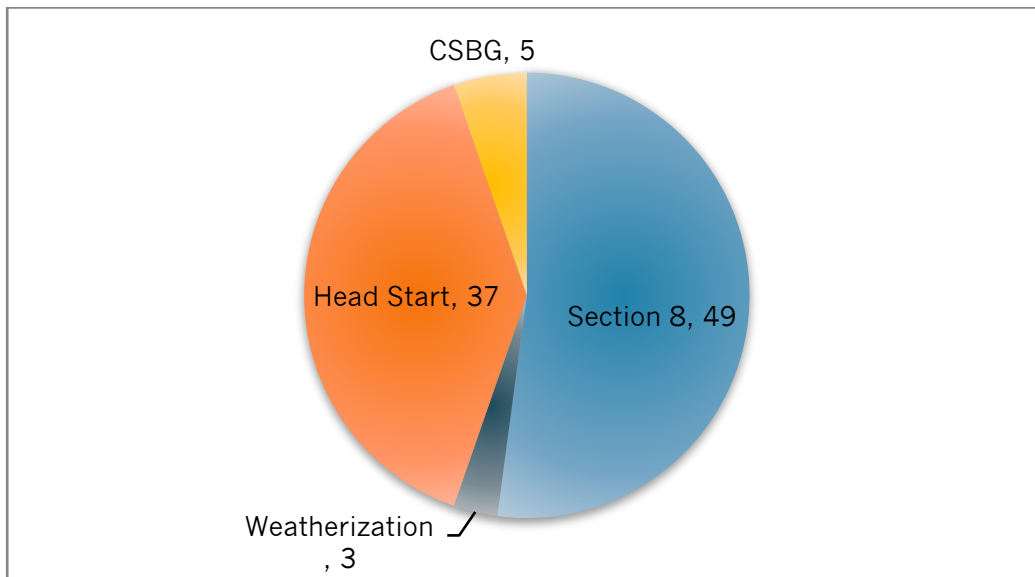

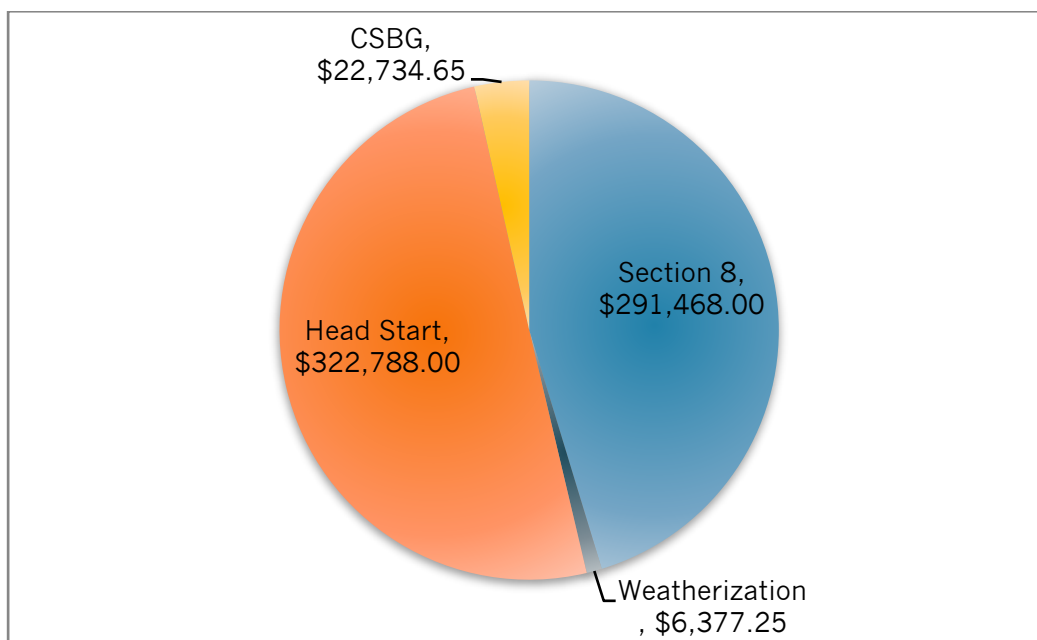

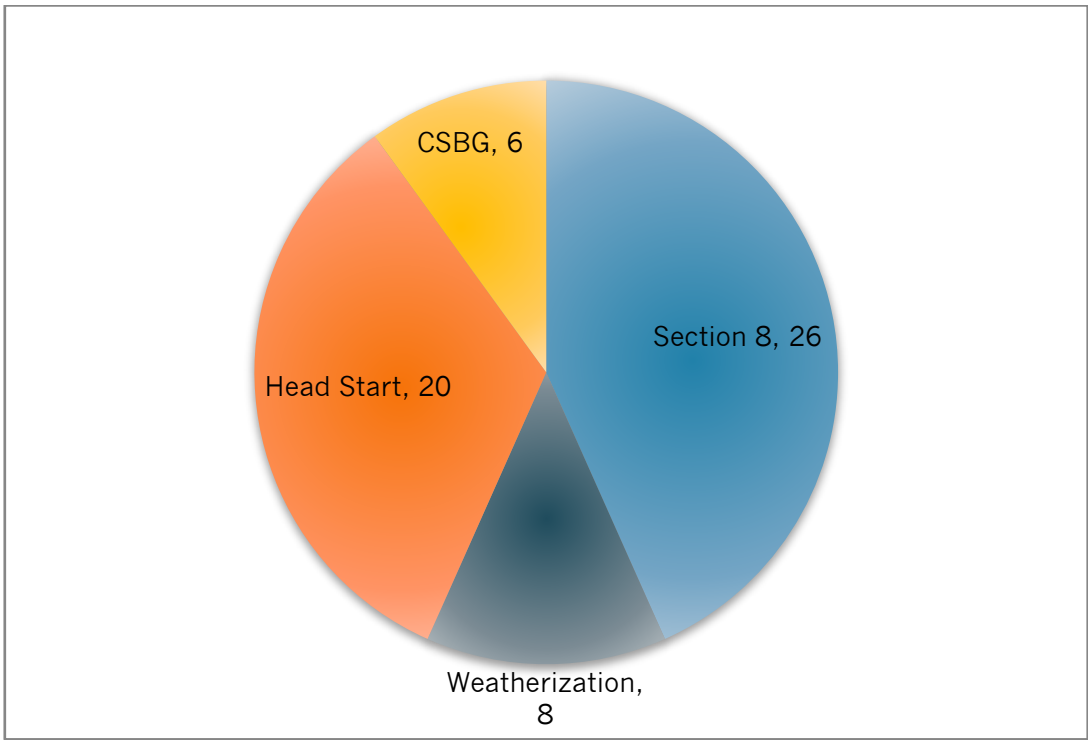

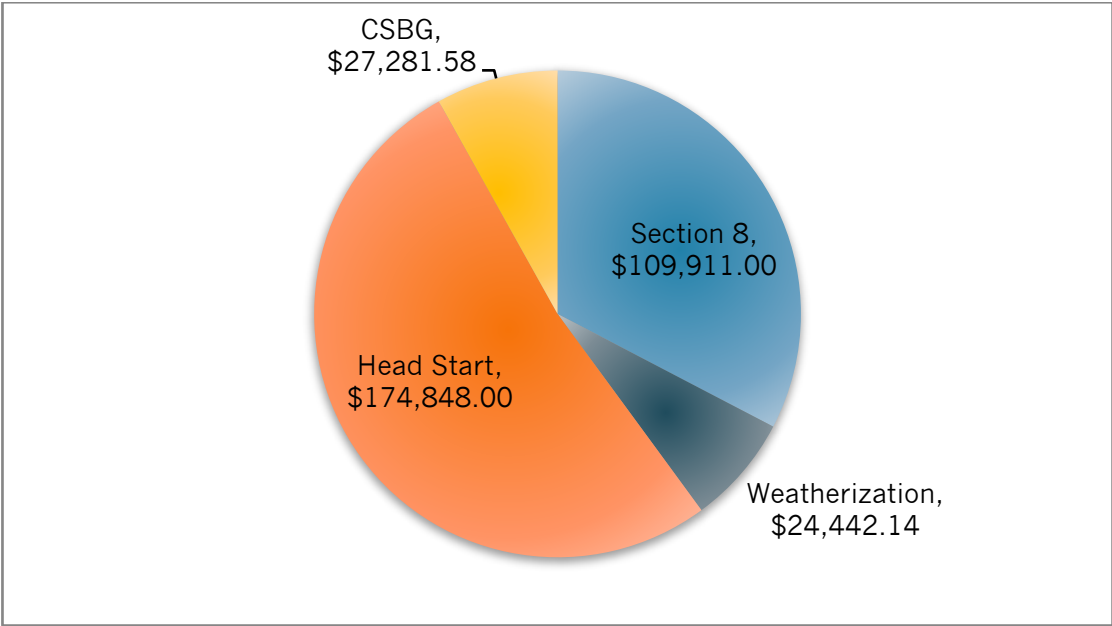

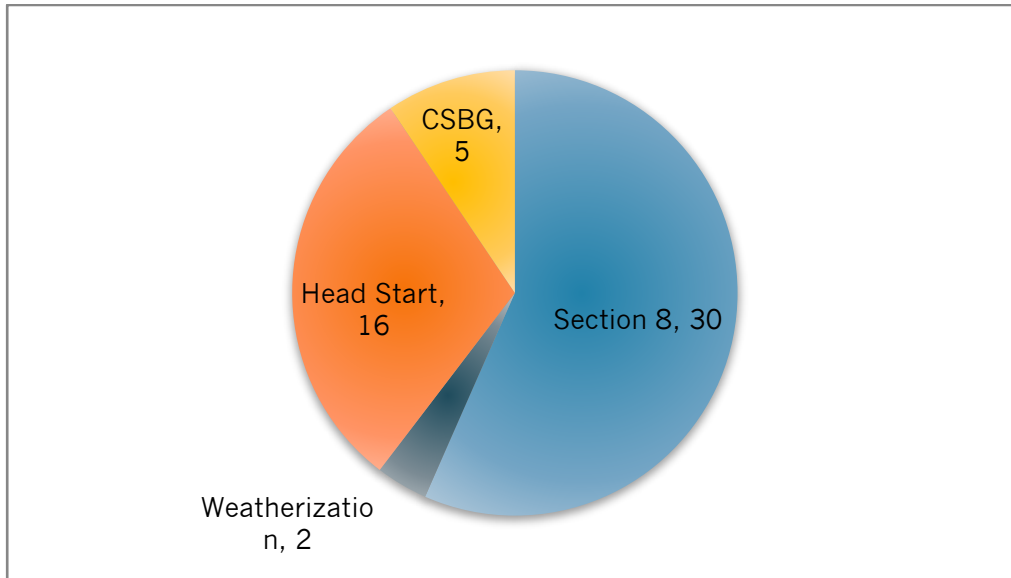

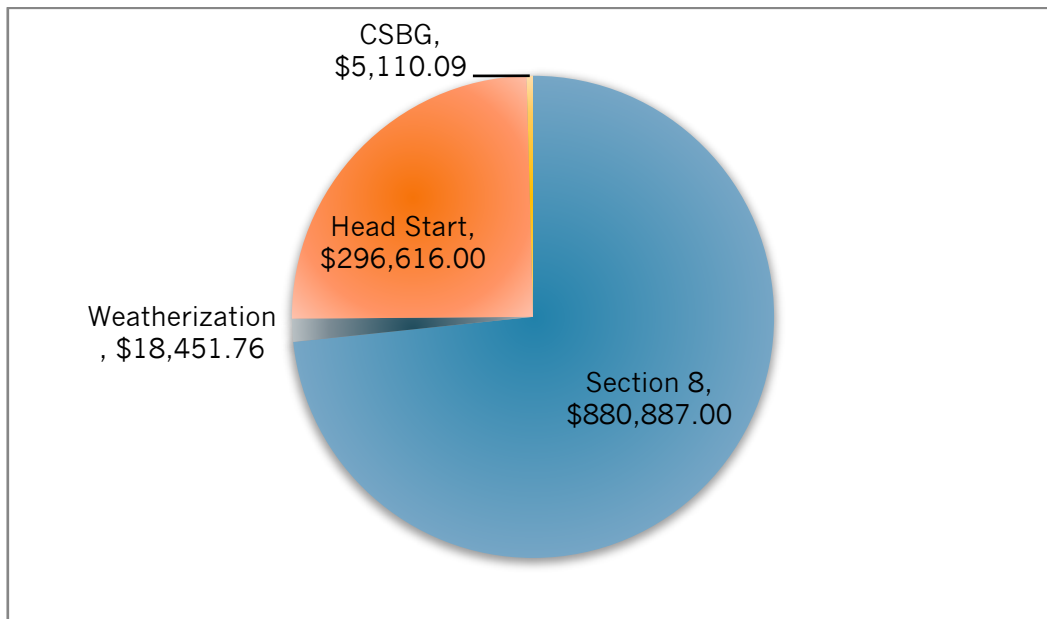

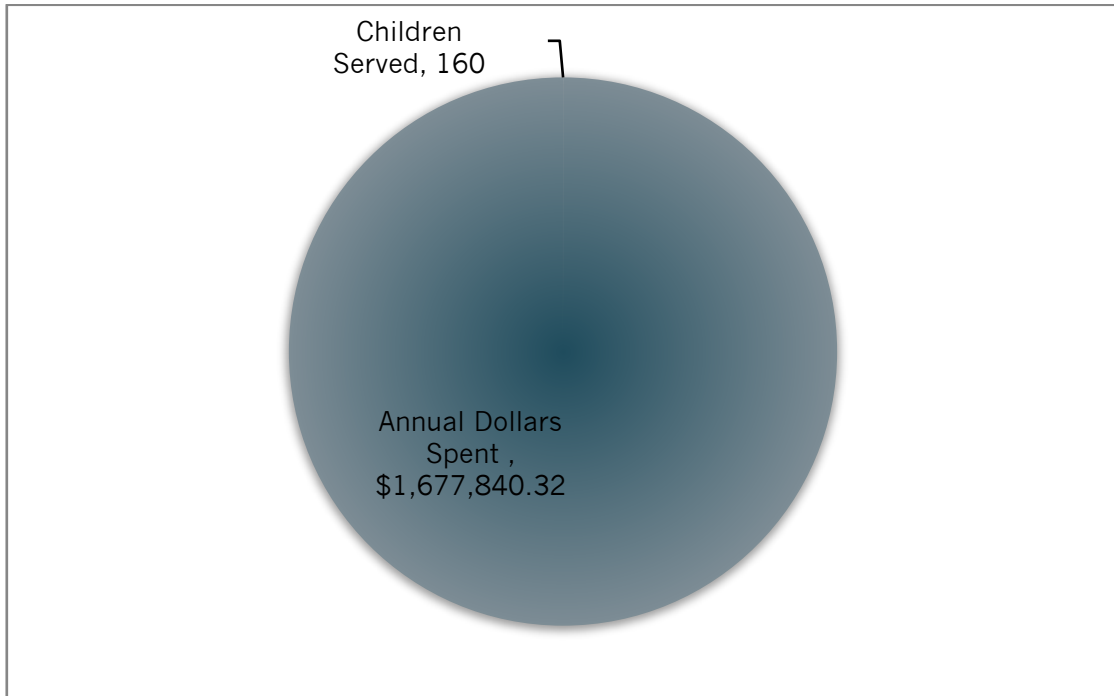

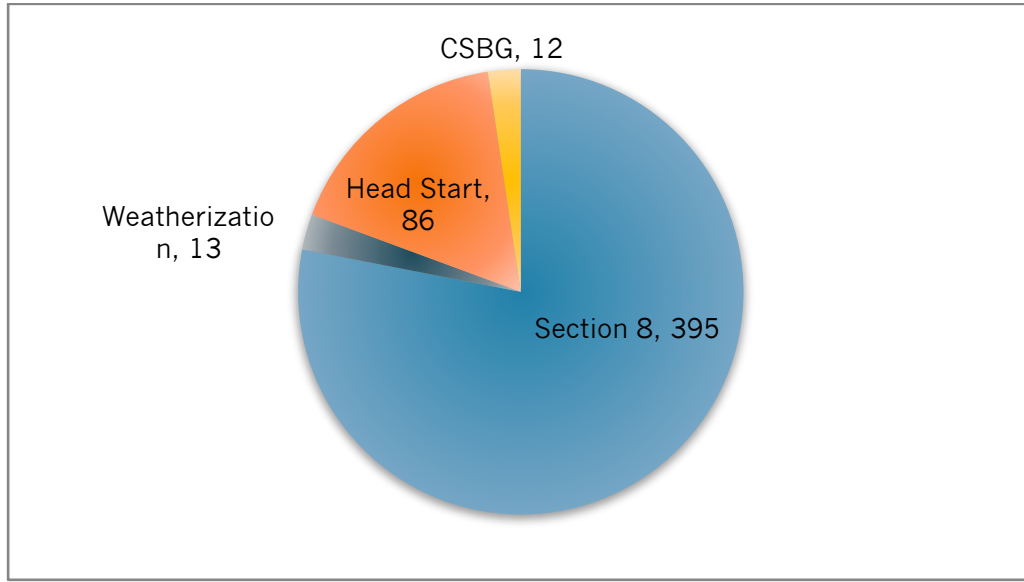

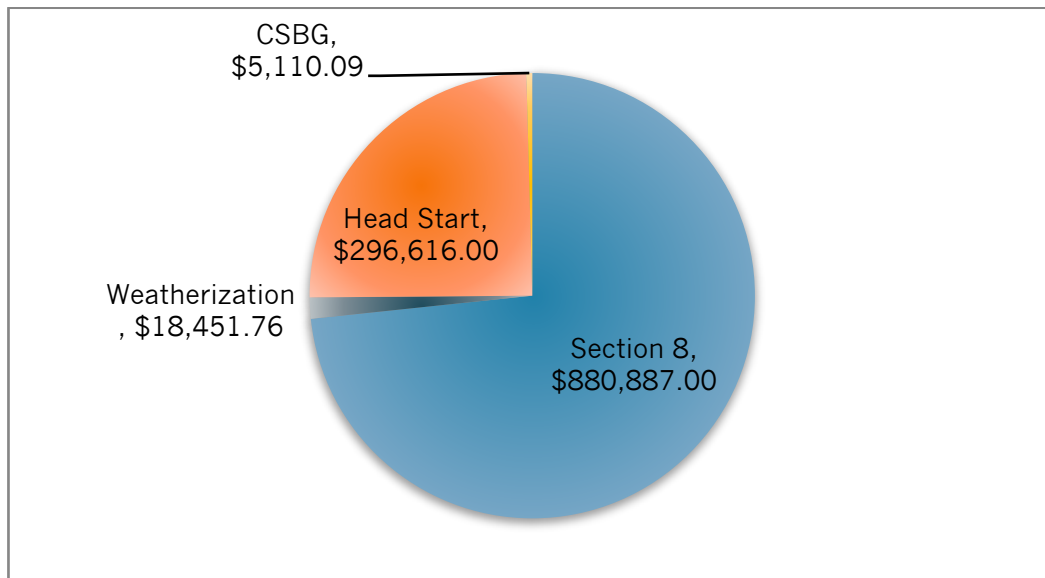

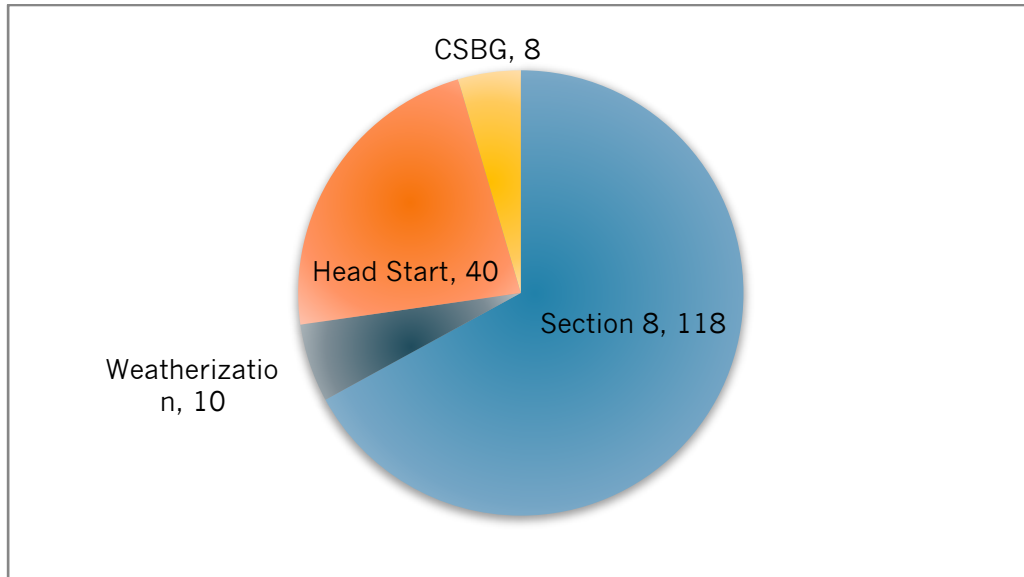

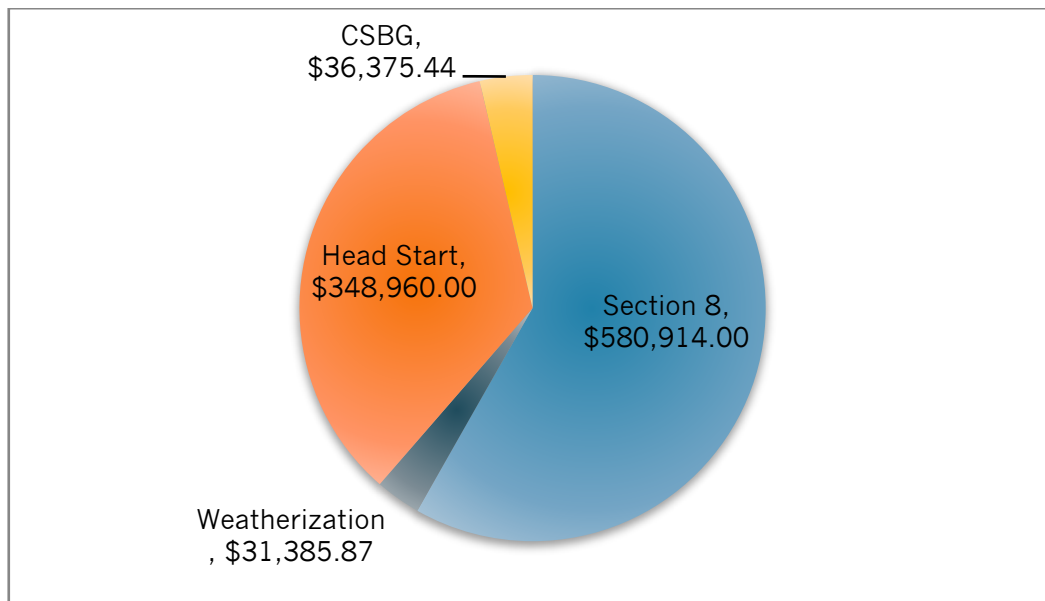

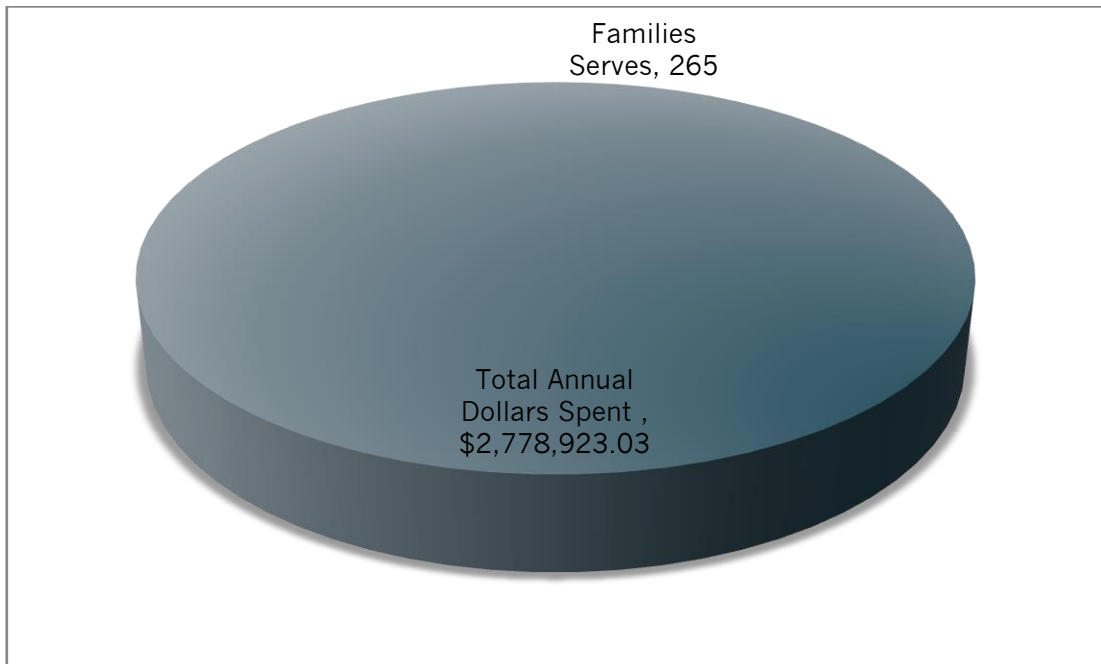

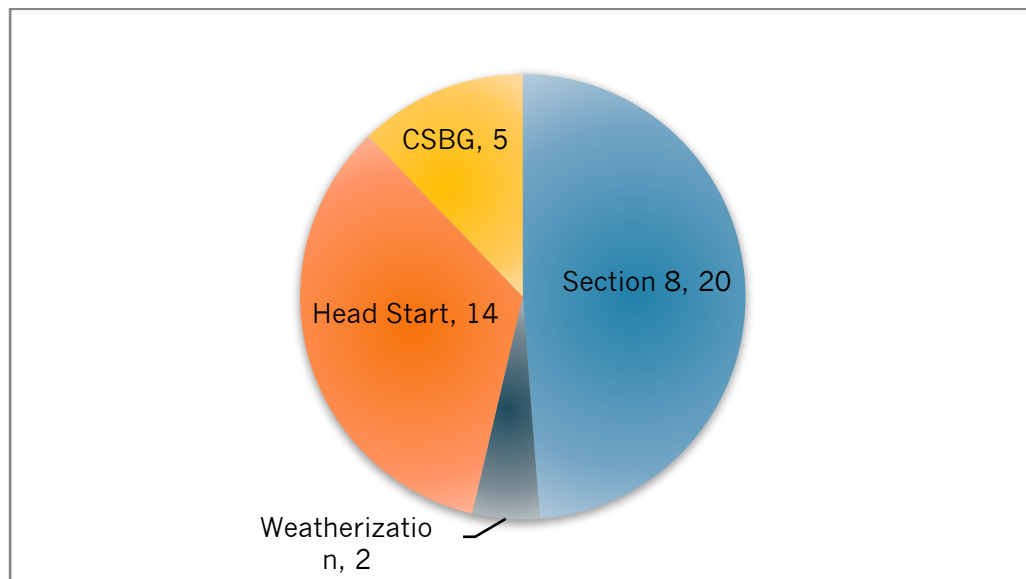

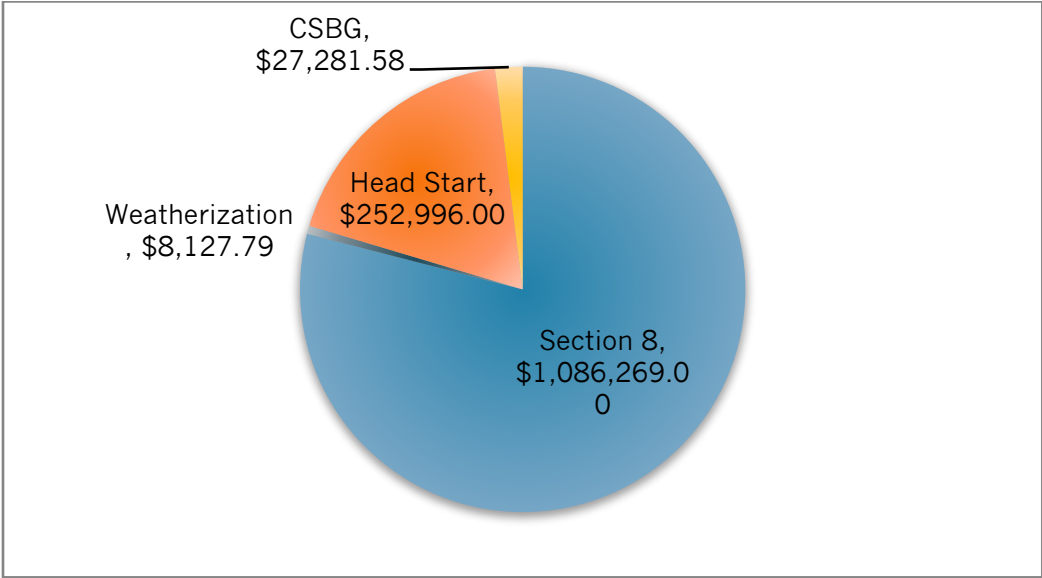

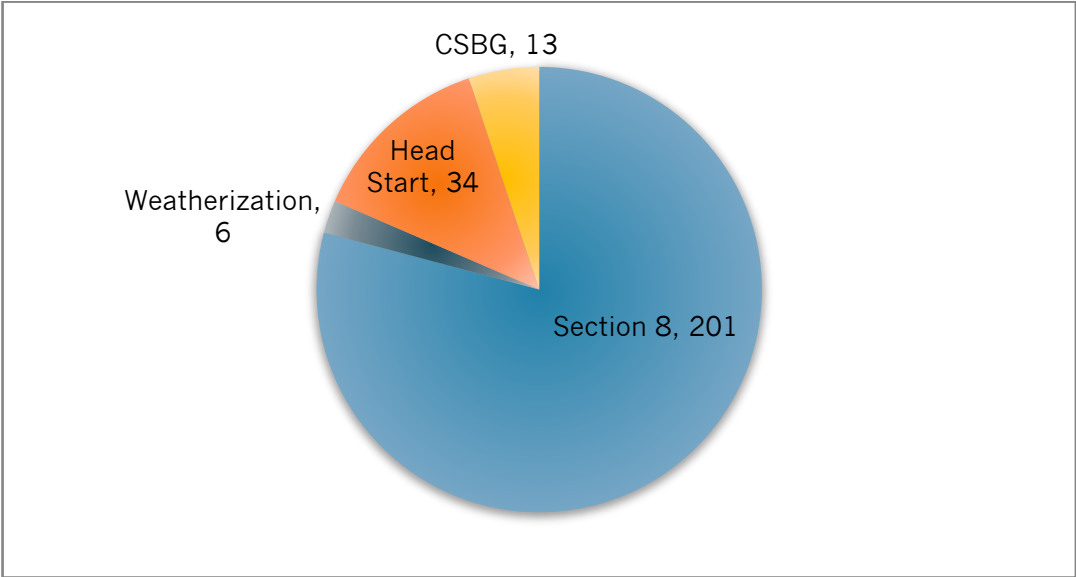
