

Who is responsible if a tree from the wetlands falls on your property?

We all know that strong winds can blow through our community, so what happens if a tree falls on your property?

The board consulted a condo attorney, the city of Bellingham, and our association insurance company to find that according to WA State law, **falling trees** are the responsibility of the homeowner on the property where the tree falls.

It is covered under your homeowners insurance and not an association responsibility. However, the association will repair any split rail fence damage. Please note: Trees cannot be removed from the wetland without a tree assessment done by a certified arborist and a permit from the city.
