ACCANO is an incorporated not for profit association that seeks to promote and grow awareness of our cultural heritage. Our vision is to foster and leave a legacy of our cultural heritage by contributing to the economic, social and civic development of the Canadian society through active and equitable integration of our members.

ACCANO is excited to launch our inaugural Scholarship Fund for Black students. Black students have historically been and continue to be underrepresented in all forms of higher education. The financial cost to attend University or College remains a barrier to many of them. To help increase access to higher education, ACCANO has established a scholarship fund to benefit local Black students at post secondary level and are actively involved in ACCANO and the community.

Number of Awards: 10 scholarships for Sault College students and 4 scholarships for Algoma University students

Value of each Award: \$500

Eligibility Criteria & Required Documents

To qualify, an applicant must satisfy the following selection criteria:

- Be a Black Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident completing high school or a University student from Sault Ste. Marie and Algoma Region; or
- International Black student residing and attending Sault College or Algoma University; and
- Full time registration in a Post-Graduate/Certificate Program or Diploma Program
- Demonstrate leadership in community service and volunteer activities

Active involvement in ACCANO will be given preference

Required documents

- A max. 500 words essay (no less than 250 words) explaining why this scholarship is important to the applicant and how the applicant demonstrates service to their community, school and ACCANO
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher or community member
- Proof of status in Canada (Canadian Citizenship; permanent residency; student study permit; etc.); and proof of enrolment in post secondary institution
