Last year which ended 30 June was a year with considerable challenges to keep members and acquire new members. Our goal was set very high and we had several transfers and deaths. due to the virus that hit in January it was very difficult to make contact with new and prospective members. The challenges financially for the entire nation also impacted renewals since many were without jobs and finances made spending \$40 for renewal a real challenge for many. We had 8 members transfer out of this world, 5 members transferred to other posts, 14 did not renew.

This year which started in July we currently have 245 members. We have had 6 new members transfer in since 1 July and we have had 1 new member join. We have started our annual renewal drive by making calls and sending emails with reminders and renewal information. Our goal is to reach 267 members this year. We need every member to be a recruiter.
