



Starting February 16, most counties will lift the mask mandate for **vaccinated** people in most indoor settings.

OFFICE (link to each county mask requirements are below)	MASK REQUIREMENT
<u>HAYWARD</u> *lifting mask mandate on 2/16/22	Vaccinated: option to remove face covering indoors Unvaccinated: continue to wear face mask indoors
<u>SAN JOSE</u> *not lifting mask mandate	Require face coverings for everyone, regardless of vaccination status, in indoor public settings and businesses
<u>ROCKLIN</u> *no change	Mask recommended indoors, regardless of vaccination status.
<u>RENO</u> *lifted immediately 2/10/22	The mask mandate will lift for all Nevadans indoors, regardless of vaccination status.
<u>LAS VEGAS</u> *lifted immediately 2/10/22	The mask mandate will lift for all Nevadans indoors, regardless of vaccination status.
<u>VANCOUVER</u> *no change for now	Require face coverings for everyone, regardless of vaccination status, in indoor public settings and businesses
<u>SEATTLE</u> *no change for now	Require face coverings for everyone, regardless of vaccination status, in indoor public settings and businesses
<u>SPOKANE</u> *no change for now	Require face coverings for everyone, regardless of vaccination status, in indoor public settings and businesses
<u>ALASKA</u>	Recommends that you wear a mask in public wherever social distancing is challenging.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vaccinated/Boosted: if you reside in a county that lifted the mask mandate, you have the option to continue to wear a face covering. • We encourage you to get vaccinated and boosted (if eligible).
