Approval of minutes from May 20th, 2021 Board Meeting: Jutta motions to approve and dispense, seconded by Mark, all in favor, Minutes passed and dispensed.

Officers reports:

- 1. President: We tried doing a July meeting, but we had no quorum/Cameras at North Pavilion
- 2. Vice President: Absent
- 3. Treasurer's Report, Financials September 2021: Financials were read.

Committee Reports:

- 3. A mailbox has been installed at the North Office so owners can now send mail to 100 Meadows Way, Boynton Beach, Fl 33436
- 4. Shopping plaza next to the North Pavilion is taking our lake water to irrigate their plaza and have never reimbursed The Meadows, we have filed a lawsuit and we will update owners as the case progresses.

Owners Discussion: Windemere entrances were discussed. Management is obtaining a survey and original landscaping plans from the City of Boynton Beach to make sure we replace any trees required by the city to avoid any citations.
