4. Matters Arising:	Andy emailed RGU (Nick Fyfe- VP) with response following community poll. Nick has acknowledged the email and replied. <b>9. Community Issues/Concerns:</b>	<p>Andy to forward on email from resident about the issue with rubbish at Inchbrae Grdens. Colin queried why there has been an increase in issues with bins not being emptied. Derek confirmed he would look into it.</p> <p>Mary highlighted experiences she had with bins and with them being emptied.</p> <p>Derek has chased up the issue with rubbish at the back of Ramsay shops.</p> <p>A reminder to residents that 2 items can be picked for free.</p> <p>Coleen advised that the street cleaner has been seen taking photos of the rubbish.</p> <p>Andy covered off the email that has been sent to Asda.</p> <p>Derek gave an update on the issue at Morrison Drive as he has had a response from council. Theres no record that a business has been registered in the street.</p> <p>Regarding Issues with untaxed cars, if we can get address of property, Derek can forward on to the housing team to deal with this.</p> <p>Colin advised there was smashed glass at Ruthrie Terrace</p> <p>Trees have been chopped down/lopped in his road. It will be November before trees are replanted.</p> <p>Email Steven Shaw re planting of trees- will these be fruit trees</p>

<b>14. Councillors Reports:</b>	Derek informed the community council he has tried to get an island at Janesfield Manor on Auchinyell Road, however it doesn't fit the criteria. It has been agreed that a sign will be put in place. Derek will look into what the criteria is for putting in an island.  It was agreed that Andy would also email Vycki Ritson regarding Janesfield Manor  RGU has agreed to put signage in Inchbrae Gardens, this is still to be done.	AM to email Vycki Ritson
<b>15. AOCB:</b>	Paul gave an update on the extension at Inchgarth Community centre. It will be a 12 month construction, providing an additional large hall with café and toilets.  This is the biggest investment in the community other than the school and it achieved cross party support at the council.
