7. Auchinyell Road Crossing-	AM read out emails he had sent to Vycki Ritson regarding the community council's position on supporting the proposal for the installation of a crossing outside Janesfield Manor.	AM to email requesting PV2 assessment-September

<b>Janesfield Manor:</b>	<p>The response was that the traffic levels were insufficient for a crossing to be installed.</p> <p>Jules suggested could speed bumps be put in place on Auchinyell Road or any other traffic calming measures could be implemented.</p> <p>In the absence of a full crossing, a refuge island would be beneficial to residents crossing the road</p> <p>Derek advised that a sign will be put in place in the next couple of months.</p> <p>Following discussions it was agreed that the community council would request a further assessment to take place to monitor traffic levels, once the school/university holidays are over to get a better idea of current traffic levels.</p>	
<b>8. Litter Issues in the community:</b>	<p>The community council has received emails from a local resident expressing concern over the increasing amount of litter being left around and discarded around the area of the new builds in Inchbrae Gardens.</p> <p>Derek has been reporting issues with litter in the community, especially large items. There are issues particularly when tenants are moving out, particularly fridge freezers and mattresses.</p> <p>The community council have also received an email from a local resident on issues with the height of the grass in the communal area on Auchinyell Gardens. There have also been issues with litter in the area. This has been reported to Derek, who will take this forward.</p>	Items that can be uplifted on fb page

Derek will email through a contact.</p> <p>Derek has also spoken to city wardens to keep an eye on the area on Morrison Drive with issues with a business being run from one of the flats there.</p>
