Theology of the Body

Bishop Kurt Burnette has asked pastors to inform their deacons and parishioners that Catholic Distance University is offering a free Online conference on St. John Paul II's Theology of the Body. St. John Paul II offered these originally as a series of talks in his general audiences on the human person and especially on sexuality, reproduction, and gender based on the revealed Faith, especially on the revelations in the early chapters of the Book of Genesis. Bishop Kurt noted: "Generally speaking, I find St. John Paul's teachings that are now called "Theology of the Body" to be remarkably similar to our own theological tradition which beautifully emphasizes that we were created in the image and likeness of God.
