## SAFETY & SECURITY

By following estate protocols, verifying visitors, and promptly reporting anything unusual, each of us plays a role in keeping Oakwood safe. Together, we can ensure that our community remains a secure and welcoming environment for all.

To ensure a safe, secure, and harmonious living environment, we kindly remind all residents of the following important protocols:







- Contractors: Must follow working hours as per the Home Improvement Guide. No contractors on public holidays unless in an emergency.
- Speed Limit: 30 km/hr for the safety of pedestrians, children, and cyclists.
- Pedestrian Awareness: Always yield to pedestrians, especially near common areas.
- Road use: Reckless or negligent driving will not be tolerated. Report unsafe driving to Estate Management.







- Noise: Respect quiet hours in the evenings and early mornings; keep noise reasonable when hosting or playing music.
- Pets: Keep pets secure and well-behaved to avoid disturbances.
- Cleanliness: Dispose of waste responsibly and keep communal areas tidy.
- Visitors: Share the correct access codes for smooth, secure entry and exit.
- Security: Report any suspicious activity immediately to the security team or estate mangement.


