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## 1. Entity overview

The purpose of Oakwood Home Owners Association ("the Association") is to enforce the set of rules, policies and procedures, as contained in its constitution or memorandum of incorporation, and supporting governance documentation, that serves the best interests of the members of the Association. In order to do this, they have appointed a Committee of Trustees or Board of Directors to act on their behalf. Their duties include, but are not limited to, the following:

- (a) Establishing a fund via levies paid by the members for maintenance, management and administration of the common area and payment of taxes, water, electricity, insurance and other necessary services;
- (b) Holding regular management and member meetings to enforce the rules and regulations;
- (c) Establishing a budget;
- (d) Authorising expenditure;
- (e) Opening a bank account(s);
- (f) Insuring the common areas;
- (g) Maintaining and repairing the common areas, and
- (i) Securing the Association by means of onsite security and/or access control and/or monitoring.

# 3. Part II

Oakwood Home Owners Association records that any and all records requested shall only be available to a requestor subject to the provisions of the Act. None of the information is automatically available without having to request access in terms of and subject to the provisions of the Act. A request for information should be in the prescribed form, addressed to the Information Officer and will be provided on payment of the required fee.

## 7. The request procedure

- a. Form of request
  - The requester must have the prescribed form being "Form C" hereto to make the request for access to a record. This must be made to the Information Officer. This request must be made to the address or electronic mail address of Oakwood Home Owners Association.
  - The requester must provide sufficient detail on the request form to enable the Information Officer to identify the record and the requester. The requester should also indicate which form of access is required and specify a postal address or fax number in the Republic, or via email. The requester should also indicate if, in addition to a written reply, any other manner is to be used to inform the requester and state the necessary particulars to be so informed.
  - The requester must identify the right that is sought to be exercised or protected, and provide an explanation of why the requested record is required for the exercise or protection of the right.
  - If a request is made on behalf of another person, the requester must submit proof of the capacity in which the requester is making the request to the satisfaction of the Information Officer.
  - Should your request be refused for whatever reason, and you wish to take the matter further, you can liaise with the South African Human Rights Commission.

#### b. Fees

A requester who seeks access to records containing personal information about that requester is not required to pay the request fee. Every other requester, who is not a personal requester, must pay the required request fee:

- The Information Officer must by notice require the requester (other than a personal requester) to pay the prescribed request fee, if any, before further processing the request.
- The fee that the requester must pay is as per the fee schedule as prescribed in the Government Gazette.

  The requester may lodge an application to the Court against the tender or payment of the request fee.

- After the Information Officer has made a decision on the request, the requester must be notified in the required form.
- If the request is granted, then a further access fee must be paid for reproduction and for search and preparation, and for any time that has exceeded the prescribed hours to search and prepare the record for disclosure.

The Minister of Justice and Constitutional Development has not made any regulations in this regard.

#### 9. Part VII

Updating of manual required under Section 51 (2)(e) of the Act

This manual will on a regular basis be updated in terms of Section 51(2) of the Act by the Association.

#### 10. Part VIII

Availability of manual under Section 51(3) of the Act

This Manual will be made available to the Human Rights Commission of South Africa and the Information Regulator. This manual will be made available on the website of the Association, if applicable.
