WINTER, ANARCHY AND DISHONOURABLE HONOURS



On the 9th of January 2024, 104 London Debaters kicked off the fresh debating year with an evening of Table Topic mini-debates – 23 people tuned in on Zoom, 7 of whom were guests!

We had 3 rounds, and the first round was chaired by one of our debate coaches, former Club President Renata Bailey-Sokol, with topics ranging from the horrors of Christmas to the joys of winter.

Next to chair was long-time member and seasoned debater, Bill Moss, who was dialling in from Wales where he now lives amongst male-voice choirs and sheep. His topics concerned which ideology is best for government - anarchy in the UK?

After the break our Founding Member Paul Carroll, DTM, chaired the third and final round of Table Topic debates. He had some current affair topics for us, touching on the dishonour of some Honours, and whether dictatorship is what's needed to fight climate change.

And then came the moment we had all been waiting for, when Club President David could reveal who had won the best speaker award in each respective round.

Round 1: Raya Ahmed for her disparaging of Christmas Round 2: Chiko Maranga for his opposition to anarchy in the UK

Round 3: Bill Moss for his call to renationalise Royal Mail

RIGHTS AND HATE CRIME

DUELLING ABOUT ANIMAL

28 people braced the wind and the rain and turned up to the first in-person meeting of 2024 – a Duel Debate meeting at the Windsor Castle Pub in Victoria.

Joann Walsh chaired the improvised Table Topic minidebates on issues ranging from lavatories to baring your legs, via tree planting, vaping and moving Parliament to the North.

Founding member of our now ten year old club, Paul Carroll, DTM, was then handed the gavel and led Stanley Billington as the Proposer and Rod Goodyer as the Opposer in the first **Duel Debate on THW Ban Animal Farming**.

Before the debate 3 supported the motion, 12 opposed it and 13 abstained. After the debate Stan had moved the vote in his direction but not enough: 7 in favour, 11 opposed and 10 abstaining.

Paul then invited William Hagerup, Immediate Past President and VP PR, to defend the motion **THW Abolish Hate Crime Legislation**, with current President David Sexton opposing.

Before this debate 8 were in favour, 11 opposed and 9 abstained. After the debate, both sides had moved the voters, but the opposition slightly more: 10 in favour, 14 opposed and 4 abstaining.

Both motions were as such defeated, but with excellent arguments made on all sides.

104 London Debaters was fully chartered (reached 20 members and was recognised by Toastmasters International) on the 26th of March 2015, but the club was founded the year before by Paul Carroll, DTM, and others in the place where we these days meet yet again, The Windsor Castle pub. 2024 therefore marks 10 years of debating at 104, as well as 100 years since the founding of Toastmasters International.

In the early days, things were less structured - often debaters were recruited as they walked through the doors and there was no set way to choose the motions.

But the key incredients were present from day one: a supportive and friendly environment for learning, practicing and enjoying debating within a Toastmasters framework – meaning feedback and mentoring are crucial elements that we value, as well as as the TM ethos of everybody working together.
