


Of 38 registered members, 23 took the survey

70% if you discount the 5 who have said they are not renewing


Do you enjoy the current meeting format with Table Topics and Prepared Debate?







I would be happy to drop Table Topics and have an extended Q&A of the debaters in the prepared debate instead.





I would be happy to have more special debate formats (duel debates/Q&A sessions/panel discussions/balloon debates, etc.) and fewer standard debates.




