Outpatient Pediatric OT

- Eligibility based on child's difficulty with daily activities at home or in the community
- Focus on
 develop-nent of
 fine motor,
 sensory, and self-care
 skills
- Services often provided in a clinic setting

School-Based OT

- Eligibility based on educational need to access classroom and curriculum
- Focus on supporting participation in school-related tasks
- Services provided at school or through school-based program

A child may not qualify for school-based OT if therapy is not needed to meet their educational goal.
