1 Who we are

We are a baby bank providing new and pre-loved essential items to families in need. Our aim is to alleviate child poverty and promote the reuse of items through the simple act of redistribution.

We collect good quality, pre-loved donations such as clothes, toys and equipment, and distribute them for free to families in need. All items are cleaned, washed and safety checked before being put into tailor made bundles lovingly prepared by our volunteers.

Referrals to our service increased 95% from 2022 to 2023, and we are now receiving around 80 requests a month across Southampton, Test Valley and the surrounding areas.

2 Mission

To alleviate the impacts of poverty in children by providing practical support to those in need.

3 Vision

By 2029 Baby Necessities will be a **core service** meeting the needs of deprived families in Southampton and the surrounding areas.

4 Our Aims

- Helping to give children the best start in life and relieving financial pressure on their families through the provision of essential items such as clothing, equipment, toys and other essentials;
- 2) **Protecting the environment by recycling of pre-loved items** which reduces items going to landfill;
- 3) Reducing the pressure on NHS and social care services by providing necessities to the families they are working with.

5 Who we help

Access to Baby Necessities is via third-party referral by professionals such as community midwives, health visitors, family support workers, social workers, educator or teacher, food bank volunteer, religious leaders, etc.

We aim to meet each request with our stock of donated items and help individuals and families from all backgrounds, regardless of their personal situation, by providing their little ones (up to the age of 5 years old) with the basic supplies they need.

8 Why do we need your help?

All of our services are provided for free to the families we support but it costs thousands of pounds each year to keep our charity operating: from core operating costs, event costs, to product costs (mattresses, breast pumps, bottles, formula, toiletries etc.). The increased demand for our services has a huge financial and resource impact on our charity. With your help, we can continue to respond to those requests and grow our charity to meet the needs of the community we serve.

By choosing us we can work with you to build an exciting calendar of activities to engage your employees, meet your business objectives and raise money. We promise to make it an unforgettable year.

10 What you get in return.

We really appreciate the time and efforts of all our corporate partners. Whether you want to raise money or donate time, skills and goods, all is gratefully received.

11 Event Partnerships

We have a calendar of Baby Necessities campaigns and events for the year. Each event has various sponsorship opportunities and provides the potential for increased positive brand exposure in the heart of the community.

11.1 Annual Campaigns

Mother's Day Appeal (March):

We want to be able to do something special for the Mothers who we support. Every year we collect new pamper items, chocolates, toiletries and gift sets to make up gift packs and distribute them with every referral throughout the month of March.

- Could your company and/or employees donate any of these items?
- Can employees make up a gift pack to donate?
- Employees can use volunteer hours to come to our HQ and assemble the gift packs ready for distribution.
- Can you donate money? just £10 can make 1 gift pack.





Pink and Green Campaign (June):

Every year in June we hold our annual fundraiser **#pinkandgreenletsbeseen**. On this day we ask our partners to join us in wearing the baby bank colours and show your support for our mission to tackle child poverty.

We have lots of activities planned in the build-up week, and on the day we like to have fun by

wearing pink and green in the most creative ways. Could your workplace get involved and donate or fundraise for Baby Necessities?

- Have a dress down day and encourage employees to wear our colours and donate money (cash or via our "just giving" page).
- Hold a cake sale and get creative with a pink and green themed frosting.
- Host a guiz and charge for entry. Donate the money raised to Baby Necessities.

11.2. Events

Summer Dinner Dance (July 2025):

Our next dinner dance will be a celebration of 5 years of Baby Necessities! It will be the perfect glamourous charity event that will help us to raise funds so we can continue to meet our objectives. This will comprise of a sit-down meal, music, entertainment, a live auction, and raffle.

- Sponsor our event and have your company logo feature on our website, social media, posters and flyers.
- Donate a raffle or auction prize to help us raise money.





Free Family Fun Day (various dates):

At different times of the year (usually in half term) we host a free family fun day full of activities, crafts and entertainment. We sympathise with those families that are unable to pay for days out and feel it is important to benefit the wider community through these events.

- Sponsor our family fun day so that we can continue to put these events on for free.
- Donate useful resources such as craft materials and refreshments.

- Donate a venue/community room that can be used for the event for free.
- Donate your time (face painters and children's entertainers etc.)

Walk the Test Way (September):

Every September we get a team together to raise money and enjoy the challenge of walking various distances along the River Test. You can choose the distance you walk which ranges from 3 miles to 25.5 miles! Could you be a part of our team and take on the challenge?







12. Fundraising Partnership

We would love to work with you to create a calendar of activity filled with innovative fundraising ideas. Fundraising brings your employees together to have fun and make a difference. It's also a perfect way for employees to develop new skills and deliver business benefits.

So, whether you work as part of a team or will be acting solo, our team are more than happy to help facilitate coming up with the idea and promoting the event.

- **Get Sporty** Run, cycle, swim, trek or set yourself another sporting challenge and get sponsored to achieve your goal!
- **Get Social** Organise a quiz night, come dine with me, casino night or a charity garden event. Simply sell tickets to attend or ask for donations from your guests. Why not hold an auction or raffle at your event to raise even more money!

If you would like to get involved with fundraising for us, please ask your company about match giving. Many employers will give you the chance to boost your fundraising by matching the money you've raised for charity on a pound-for-pound basis or up to an agreed amount. This means you'll raise even more to help vulnerable families.

13. Corporate and staff volunteering

Your business can make a positive impact on the local community, so why not escape the office and spend some time helping us? Volunteering is a great way to build staff skills, such as teamwork and communication.

14. Support us financially

The families we support are facing a range of challenges – extreme financial difficulty, unemployment, homelessness, domestic abuse, asylum seekers and more. What they all need are the basic essentials for their babies and young children.

Can you donate a one-off monetary donation that could help support one of the above projects, and/or fund the items we need to buy new, or to simply keep our doors open? Or perhaps sign up as a monthly supporter, match your employees' fundraising, or donate a share of the profits from sales.

£300 can fund 20 family toiletry bundles

£500 can provide 20 manual breast pumps

£1,000 can buy 25 cot bed mattresses

£5,000 can support 50 newborns with moses basket starter kits

£10,000 would be a significant help towards our yearly running costs and help keep our doors open
