Easy to transplant from seedling	Cabbage, Cauliflower, Chinese Cabbage, Eggplant, Endive, Kale, Lettuce, Peppers, Sugarcane, Swiss Chard, Tomatillo, Tomatoes, tropical Spinaches such as Okinawa or Malabar.			
Transplant carefully from seedling	Amaranth, Calabaza, Long Squash, Luffa, Mustard, Papaya, Pineapple, Seminole Pumpkin, Sweet Potatoes			
Sow seed directly	Beans (bush, lima, pole), Carrots, Cucumbers, Okra, Onions (bunching), Peas (southern such as black eye or pigeon, Squashes, Turnips)
