#### Winter Weather Is Coming!

Roads Chairman, Brian Snyder, and Property Manager, Wesley Baugher, will work to keep our roads clear of snow this coming winter season when snowfall is between 2-5 inches. If accumulation is greater than 5 inches, hiring commercial assistance may be necessary. If less than 2 inches of snow, roads are typically not plowed. Please do them a huge favor by not parking vehicles along roadways and remove all trash containers as well to allow for safe and efficient plowing.

### Water Quality Update

Thank you Derek Arnold and Brian Snyder for continuing to measure the water quality of our lake. Testing on 9/12/2025 detected no harmful toxins at the beach (though levels may be different at other locations). E.coli tests at the beach were 132 MPN/100mL. GAPOA follows VDH/EPA Guidelines. If E.coli levels are above 235 MPN/100mL a swimming advisory is issued. If you have questions, please contact Derek or Brian.

The leaves are down and many have settled into the ditches and culverts. Please do what you can to clear them away to help divert water off the roads.

Due to the exceptionally dry summer and fall, please exercise extreme caution regarding outdoor burning and check the Virginia Dept of Forestry's website for burn bans that may have been inacted. Currently, burning is not permitted until 4:00pm.
