FECAL CONTAMINATION OF BEACH WATER

Levels of *E. coli* in beach water are present
(last tested on DATE) at a concentration associated with an
increased risk of illness from exposure to
fecal contamination.

If you choose to swim or if you choose to let your dogs go
swimming, avoid and rinse!

AVOID accidental ingestion or inhalation of water

DO NOT let dogs drink the water or eat scum or
material on the shore, **AND**

ALWAYS rinse off well with clean water and soap

Exposure to fecal contamination may cause illness!

Call your doctor or veterinarian if you or your animals
have sudden or unexplained sickness.
