# Treasurer's Report was presented by Debbie Turck.

- Assessment Notices will be mailed in February, due March 15. A payment button has been set up on our website for online payments.
- 50% of our budget has been spent so far. Total revenue is \$2,162 and total expenses are \$55,001, mainly due to unexpected dam repairs costing \$21,000.
- The ending balance in our account is \$27,256.

### Road Maintenance was presented by Brian Snyder.

- GA Roads took a beating during the Turkey Ridge bridge replacement.
- Tall Pines before the stop sign needs significant repairs.
- Between Wesley on the tractor, Brian on the motor grader and additional gravel dispersed the roads are in pretty good shape.
- Speeding and impatience on our road's causes erosion of gravel into the ditches and safety concerns.

- Several instances were presented sighting property damaged, road damage and near misses.
- Speed bumps were mentioned as a deterrent.
- We remind the community that the sheriff's department is obligated to enforce traffic laws and we suggest reporting any instances to them.

## **Environmental and Safety was presented by Sara Johnson.**

- Committee discusses forest fire risks.
- Water quality at the lake was discussed, and prior year's levels of high E. coli and hazardous algae blooms will continue to be a concern.
- Several proposals were made to monitor and/or mitigate these issues.
- For testing, professional services or "do it yourself" kits were proposed. Information will be gathered, and a formal proposal submitted in the future.
- The need to inform our residents about water quality was also mentioned.
- Discussion on the geese population and its impact on water quality continues.
- A vote was done to register GAPOA to remove and destroy eggs. We need to ask community members to help identify nesting areas.
  - Members in favor: Michele, Debbie T, Debbie B, Sara, Brian, Mary Kay, Tina, Fred.
- Several methods (devices) for goose deterrent were discussed and phone numbers
  provided for additional resources. Information will be gathered, and a formal proposal
  submitted in the future.
- An option to dispatch during open hunting season might be a consideration.
- This will be an ongoing expense and effort. Community involvement will need to be considered when implementing any solution.
- Request was made to remove beavers from the lake, citing road and property damage and potential danger.
- Suggestions were made to hire a professional to assess the beaver damage and provide recommendations and costs.
- Do homeowners have the legal right to dispatch beavers on their own property with concerns raised about using firearms, citing a previous violation of rules and regulations?
- Is this a GAPOA issue to resolve or should individual property owners take on the responsibility?
- Beaver population management plan to be discussed in the future and Sara will talk with effected property owners.

- [] Have Calvin's Animal Damage Control representative assess the beaver dams and lodge in the community lake and provide a quote to remove the beavers.
- [] Share research on E. coli and blue-green algae test kits for consideration in developing a water quality monitoring proposal.
- [] Develop a proposal on a water quality monitoring plan for 2024 including testing costs and options for consideration by the board.
- [] Research goose deterrent options and prices to include in a comprehensive goose remediation proposal.
- [] Reinvest our annuity funds (Fidelity Life Investments) which end/mature next year.
- [] Add pea gravel to playground.
- [] Repair, remove or replace bench at playground.
