

Disappearing Hourglass

Would you enjoy creating a quilt from a simple block that looks complex? Sign up for our Disappearing Hourglass class on November 8 and learn to make two versions of an easy block that starts with a simple hourglass and results in two very different but impressive quilts. Both blocks start with high-contrast pairs of ten-inch squares, so get out those layer cakes you've been saving.

You'll need your machine and normal sewing supplies; an iron and mat; a rotary cutter, mat, and ruler (a rotating mat is useful); and a pair of high-contrast ten-inch squares for each block.

Make a quilt of any size using your approximately 11 1/2" finished blocks, and the full effect of the design emerges when the top is put together, and is stronger when solids or small prints are used.
