

# Piecing the Pineapple

A half day fabric foundation piecing workshop with Julia McLeod


Tuesday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 9:30 am – 1:30 pm

Cost: \$25 for members, \$30 for nonmembers, plus \$15 kit fee

Piece the traditional Pineapple block using a uniquely lightweight, printed foundation made by EZ Piecing exclusively for Julia's classes. This light-as-a-feather product adds no extra weight or bulk to your blocks and is suited to working with all fabrics, especially silks and other fabrics that tend to slip and fray. We'll discuss color choices and careful color placement through fussy cutting. Use your stash of neckties, saris, kimono and more, or make this block using regular quilters' cottons.

## Supply List



There is a \$15 kit fee for the foundation pack of 12 pineapple blocks by EZ Piecing. You can either purchase this kit from Julia prior to the workshop (recommended, no shipping fees) or you can order it from

- One block can be completed using about ten neckties - 5 light, 5 dark. Other silks from scarves, furnishings and clothing are also suitable. Avoid very sheer fabrics. If using quilters' cottons you will need about 1/4 yard each of one light and one dark fabric - or make it scrappy. Bring plenty of fabric so you have choices. Expect to make one or two blocks in a day.
- Standard sewing supplies: sewing machine, cord and pedal, bobbins, regular presser foot or walking foot
- Thread in a neutral color
- Scissors, thread snips and seam ripper, rotary cutter with a good blade
- Cutting mat and ruler
- Add-a-quarter ruler - optional but not essential
- Iron and ironing surface
- Pins
- Notebook/Sketchbook and pen/pencil
