## **Crochet Leggy Frog Pattern**

- 7 ½ inches for big fluffy frog
- 4 inches for medium fluffy frog

<u>Materials:</u> (can vary depending on what type of yarn you are using) For this pattern, I am doing the medium fluffy frog.

- Crochet hook, for my dollar tree Just Chenille Super Bulky 6 yarn, I use a 5mm hook. I recommend sizing down so that there are no big holes in the project.
- Darning needle
- 7 mm Safety eyes (x2)
- Stuffing

sc in each (18)

For the big fluffy frog, I used the Bernat Plush Yarn at Joann Fabrics with a 8mm crochet hook. The Safety eyes I used are 10 mmm.

## **Abbreviations Ch -Chain Stitch** St- Stitch **Slst-Slip Stitch Sc- Single Crochet** Inc-Increase **Invdec-Invisible Decrease Bo- Bobble Stitch (4-dc bobble)** Pattern: chain 10, sc down the FLO of the chain (you should have 9 sc by the end) sc 1, bo, sc 5, bo, sc on the BLO of the chain (you should have 18 sc total by the end) sc in each (18) sc in each (18) insert safety eyes in th bobble stitches you created in round 2 sc in each sc, {ch 13, sl 3, ch 4, sl 3, ch 4, sl 3, sl into the last sl of your first finger, sl all the way down the ch.} Sc 9 in next, arm, sc 8 (18) sc in each (18) sc in each (18) sc in each (18)

## **Notes:**

Placements of the arms and eyes may vary, so feel free to adjust where the arms and eyes go if needed. Just make sure to have the right number of stitches at the end of your rounds.

Feel free to add or subtract rows from the frogs' body to get the look you want.

After you finish the row with adding the arms, do not single crochet into the arm in the following row.

## How to do a bobble stitch:

YO: yarn over

YO, insert hook, pull out a loop, YO pull through 2 loops. You should have 2 loops on your hook (one from the loop you started with and a new one from the unfinished double crochet.)

Keep the 2 loops on your hook and repeat [YO, insert hook, pull out a loop, YO pull through 2 loops], all in the same stitch and keeping everything on the hook until you have 5 loops on your hook. Then, pull through all of the loops. This should all result in one bobble stitch being formed on one stitch.
