Community Service

Our next Community Service Workshop will be <u>WEDNESDAY</u>, OCTOBER 9, 10:00 to 2:00, at Fair Lane Acres clubhouse, 819 49th Ave Ter W. We'll be preparing our fat-quarter grab bags to be sold at the show. Any profit made is used to offset the cost of batting and other supplies. We'll need lots of helpers - come for the whole time or just an hour or two.

In August, 33 dog beds and 3 fleece blankets were donated to the Manatee County Humane Society. We also donated 6 lap quilts to Tidewell Hospice. In September, the Humane Society received 29 dog beds and a bunch of bed sheets.

And, speaking of dog beds - please use smallish pieces of quilting-weight fabric and batt **only** to stuff the covers - not yardage. If there are long "trimmings" from the edge of a quilt after quilting, please cut into smaller pieces before stuffing the covers - don't roll them into a ball and put them into the covers. Before closing the cover, give it a little "fluff" - nobody likes a lumpy mattress!

Quilts-to-be-quilted, quilts that need binding, and dog bed covers will be available at the Community Service table before and after the meeting.


