ULMER QUILTING FRAME Measures 47" x 18"

End view showing hinged section Making it easy to remove the Pieces connected by springs.

Drape quilt "sandwich" over the frame. After checking for tautness top and bottom, insert spring pieces and pull hinge down.

Stitch the middle of your quilt first, then shift to adjoining sections – right, left, top, bottom - until quilt is finished.

Legs fold under for storage.
