February 5 Meeting

Our program for February will be Molly Waddell, who will be presenting a trunk show and speaking about her quilting journey. The day following will feature Molly's stained-glass workshop, with a choice of two patterns, at Quilters' Haven. There is still plenty of space for you to sign up for this workshop, so get your form in as soon as possible! A kit will be available so all you need to round up is fabric from your stash. Bring your UFO projects to show, and we hope to have our donor quilt tickets ready for pickup as well. And there will be Community Service projects to finish, so plan on taking at least one home with you! See you there!

Tips and Tricks

Wrap your binding around a straw and when you are done cut of the tips. Put the straw on the spindle of your machine. The binding will come off evenly as you sew your binding on your quilt.

Community Service

Our next Community Service Workshop will be Thursday, February 8, 10:00-2:00, at Fair Lane Acres Clubhouse, 810 49th Ave Ter W. We'll be layering quilts, so we'll need many helpers for choosing, piecing & ironing the backings; putting the layers together; & bagging the quilt "sandwiches". There's a fridge & microwave available if you bring your lunch. Please bring your usual sewing supplies; we'll provide rulers, cutting mats, & irons.

In January, Manatee County Humane Society received 16 dog beds and 18 cat mats. REMINDER: Dog beds should be stuffed with lightweight (quilting) fabrics or batting ONLY!!! Please do not use heavy fabrics (think canvas, home dec, etc.) or wool. Fabrics should be cut into pieces no bigger than 6" or 7" & "fluffed". There are instructions at the Community Service table. Cat mats are NOT stuffed - they should be flat, When a cat is adopted, the "family" is given a temporary crate for transportation - a cat mat is placed inside so that kitty has something to "knead". The mats are also used after surgery for comfort.

As usual there'll be quilt sandwiches that need to be finished and dog bed covers waiting to be stuffed at the Community Service table. Please stop by to pick up one or two, Thanks.


