January 8 Meeting

Our first meeting of 2024 will feature Cecilia Reid, who will bring a trunk show and talk about feedsacks in the history of guilting. She'll have things for sale and will answer your questions. Also, our Ready for the Show UFO begins in January. If you haven't yet joined this UFO group, you can still sign up! Tips and Tricks

It's time to put your borders on your quilt. If they are not put on properly, did you know you can end up with wavy borders?

The correct way to put borders is to measure the top and bottom of quilt and, the middle. Don't be surprised if you have two to three different measurements, this is normal and what will cause waves in your border.

Add the different measurements together then divide the total by the number of different measurements. The total should be the length of your borders. Once you have your top to bottom borders on repeat this process for the side borders,

Taking this extra step will eliminate wavy borders.

Community Service

After thoughtful discussion, we've decided that we would cancel the Community Service workshop that was originally scheduled for January 11, 2024. The plan was to layer quilts, but after taking inventory we found we have a ton of quilt tops (with batting and backing) that need to be quilted in storage already - there just isn't room for any more right now. So, we are asking **PLEASE** to take one or more of these kits home from the January meeting. Quilt (and bind if you want to) and return at a later meeting.

There are no finished quilts in storage - in December, we were able to donate 65 quilts to Guardian Ad Litem and 35 quilts to Beds 4 Kids Manatee/Sarasota, In addition, His Girls Discipleship received 4 adult quilts, 7 quilts for toddlers, and 2 quilts for twin newborn girls (saw their picture on Facebook - they are just too cute!)

And here's our end-of-the-year info - in 2023, we donated 256 dog beds, 191 cat mats, 10 yards of terry cloth, and 2 sheets to Manatee County Humane Society. Guardian Ad Litem received 150 quilts; Vietnam Veterans of America received 14 quilts, His Girls received a total of 16 quilts and Beds 4 Kids received 35 quilts. Thank you everyone for helping the Guild maintain its status as a 501c3 tax-exempt charity - you're all amazing!!




